Message from the Pastor



Dear Friends in Christ,

Like most of the world, when Pope Francis was chosen as our new Holy Father on March 13, 2013, I had never heard of Jorge Bergoglio. Raised in Argentina and a member of the Society of Jesus since 1958, he was a teacher in high schools and seminaries before serving in leadership for the Jesuits. He became a Bishop in 1993 and a Cardinal in 2001. His life was not always easy. He had health problems. He led the Jesuits in Latin America during agitated political times. He was a Bishop as participation in religion declined and scandal scarred the Church.

He became the Bishop of Rome after the resignation of Pope Benedict and was given the charge to “reform the Church,” but inherited Church leadership that was not in agreement on what that reform would look like or if it was even needed. Then there was COVID. As Pope, he traveled to places Popes had never visited. He served the poorest of the poor and chose their Bishops to be Cardinals, something new as well. He spoke of the struggles of family life as a brother and uncle who knows family drama. He called us to be merciful and not so quick to judge. He asked us to have a more missionary mindset as Christians and as a Church. He angered people on the “right” when he pushed things too far, and those on the “left” when he did not push far enough. He prayed. He spoke of himself as a sinner who was looked upon by God in love. In his final months of sickness, he did not hide his infirmity but, like Pope John Paul II showed the dignity of humanity even in its frailty and dependence as he appeared in a wheelchair, dependent on others for assistance.

Please do as Pope Francis asked and pray for his soul. Pray, as we ought for every person who died, that God be merciful and generous. Rejoice in some aspect of his life and ministry and give thanks to God. If you have some reason to be angry with the Holy Father, offer forgiveness and ask for the grace to surrender those feelings at this time. He has gone where we will all go, into eternity, to face the Lord and give an accounting for our lives.

In the days to come, the 266th successor of Saint Peter will be elected. The leadership of the Church, as established by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, will continue. Pray that the Cardinals participating in the Conclave, 108 of whom were appointed by Francis (of the 135 who will vote), are guided by the Holy Spirit in choosing the one God desires. Mary, Mother of the Church, pray for us!


