

NEW PARISHIONERS ~ Call the Parish Office for an appointment to register.

MOVING ~ Please notify the Parish Office with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

BAPTISM ~ Second, third and fourth Sunday of month at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

MARRIAGE ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Parish Office for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

RECONCILIATION ~ Mondays (6pm-7pm); Wednesdays (7am-8am); Saturdays (4pm-4:50pm)

HOMEBOUND VISITATION ~ Please contact the Parish Office.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK ~ First Saturday of the month following 8:30am Mass.

Message from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,



Happy Mother's Day to all of the mothers, godmothers, spiritual mothers and women who encourage and love us! In this week in which the world was talking about "the pope", I thought it was good to share three quotes on the vocation of motherhood from our three recent Holy Fathers:

The Dignity of the Mother: Motherhood is a woman's vocation: It was yesterday, it is today, it will always be. It is her eternal vocation. There comes to my mind the words of a song of my country. These say that a mother is the one who understands everything and embraces each of us with her heart. And they add that today the world is 'hungrier and thirstier' than ever for that motherhood which, physically or spiritually, is woman's vocation, as it was Mary's. My prayer is that today, too, the dignity of the mother will be recognized and protected in the family and in society. It will depend, above all, on you, young people, if this happens in the world of tomorrow. Endeavour at once to look at your mothers with the eyes with which Jesus looked at His. Let her, the Virgin Mother, who is our hope, help you in this your resolution.

The next blood drive will be here before you know it! We are looking forward to the same wonderful participation by our amazing donors that we have had in the past.

The drive is now available on the Red Cross website for sign ups. Register early and get your preferred time! Go to <https://www.redcrossblood.org> If assistance is needed for sign up or you have donation eligibility questions, please reach out to 1-800-REDCROSS (1-800-733-2767). Flyers with additional info and QR codes and news about the June reward will be available in the back of church and in neighborhood businesses soon.

Note that slots labeled as “**Blood**” should be used for the most common donation, during which one unit (approximately a pint) of ‘whole blood’ is given. The “**Power Red**” slots should only be used for those planning a ‘power red’ donation, where the red cells are collected but most of the plasma and the platelets are returned to the donor but effectively two units are donated. These donors must meet specific eligibility requirements and have type A neg, B neg, or O blood. We encourage those able to make such a donation to do so. Double the gift in one appointment!


