

NEW PARISHIONERS ~ Call the Parish Office for an appointment to register.

MOVING ~ Please notify the Parish Office with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

BAPTISM ~ Second, third and fourth Sunday of month at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

MARRIAGE ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Parish Office for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Jean Broden, a lifelong parishioner and beloved local artist, has begun making sketches of the 22 new saint images that will be added to our Church over the next year or so. The names were submitted by parishioners, and the list was discussed with staff and others to make the best possible choices to provide more models of holiness for our Parish as we gather in the sacred space of our Church. I also wanted to allow for a more ethnically diverse representation of saints (and saints to be) as our community becomes more diverse. We all like to see saints who look like (and lived like) us.

At this point, our new saints (and blessed and venerables) include:

- ◆ Philadelphia's St. John Neumann & St. Katherine Drexel (whose images will be on either side of the main doors of the Church). These images will go on the panels across the front of the choir loft
- ◆ St. Josephine Bahkita (a former slave from Sudan)
- ◆ St. Alphone (an Indian woman who founded a religious community of teachers)
- ◆ St. Carlo Acutis (Italian teenager)
- ◆ Ven. Carlo Rodriguez (a layman and catechist from Puerto Rico)
- ◆ Saints Zellie and Louis Martin (the parents of St. Therese)
- ◆ St. Gianna Molla (an Italian wife, mother and physician)
- ◆ Ven. Francis Van Thuan (Vietnamese Archbishop)
- ◆ Ven. Matt Talbot (Irish layman who battled alcoholism)
- ◆ Ven. Julia Greeley (American former slave who served the people of Denver)
- ◆ Ven. Nicholas Black Elk (Native American Lakota husband and father who served Catechist)
- ◆ St. Elizabeth Seton (American wife, mother who founded the Sisters of Charity)
- ◆ Ven. Fr. Gus Tolton (the first African-American Priest)
- ◆ St. Teresa of Calcutta (Albanian-Indian servant of the poor)
- ◆ St. Faustina (Polish nun who received Divine Mercy message)
- ◆ St. Maximilian Kolbe (Polish priest martyred in the Holocaust)
- ◆ Saint Dymphna (Irish laywoman, victim of domestic abuse)
- ◆ St. Edith Stein (German Carmelite, born Jewish, martyred in the Holocaust)
- ◆ St. Pope John Paul II (Polish Pope)
- ◆ Servant of God Akash Bashir (a layman from Pakistani who died protecting his parish Church from an attack)
- ◆ St. Padre Pio (beloved Italian Priest and wonder worker)
- ◆ St. Michael the Archangel and Saint Valerian (husband of St. Cecilia).

If you have thoughts on the list (and a good argument to remove someone or add a new person), let me know!

Pilgrimages


Pilgrimages are being planned for the following:

Our collection for July 19-20 was an amazing \$19,804 (424 envelopes; 113 e-givers). Our weekly average is \$20,126 (towards our goal of \$19,135). Thank you for your goodness!

Saint Cecilia had 588 parishioners complete the **DMI survey in Lent 2025** (we had 399 participants in 2022 when it was first taken). Over the summer, we will share “the results” of the survey. Father Chris, the Next Generation Parish Team, the Parish Staff, and others will begin reviewing the results to set new goals for our Parish Pastoral Plan for 2026-2029. There will be listening sessions for the whole parish in the Fall to gain more feedback and ideas as we move forward, guided by the Holy Spirit!

The first set of data we will review is called the **Four Factors for a Thriving Parish**. These data points, based on research with parishes across the United States, help us be a “thriving”

parish, leading others to Christ and living as authentic missionary disciples. The four areas are: **Leadership, Sunday Experience, Spiritual Practices, and Missionary Impulse**.

The final area to review is **Missionary Impulse** (*the willingness of our Parish to go out to others*). We have made some improvements, but this is an area that we (like most Catholics) have much to learn and develop.

- ◆ I invited someone to a parish activity increased from 41% to 72% (for inviting someone at least once).
- ◆ I invited someone to Mass increased from 52% to 70% (for

inviting someone at least once).


- ◆ Like in 2022, 13% of the parish have invited someone to consider the priesthood or religious life.
- ◆ I have answered a spiritual question of another person increased from 79% to 83%
- ◆ I volunteered to serve another (at least once a month) increased from 25% to 32%.
- ◆ I shared the story of Jesus with someone (at least once a month) increased from 24% to 29%.


