NEW PARISHIONERS ~ Call the Parish Office for an appointment to register.

MOVING ~ Please notify the Parish Office with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

BAPTISM ~ Second, third and fourth Sunday of month at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

MARRIAGE ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Parish Office for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

Message from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

The word Church derives from the word "gathering". This makes sense; the Church is much more than a building. It is a gathering of people seeking to live as God's beloved sons and daughters. St. Cecilia is blessed with many wonderful people who gather in so many ways to be Church! I would like to make mention of a few this week.

First, Bobbi Mitchell, our school secretary who is retiring this week after more than forty years of service! To put it in perspective, she has served St. Cecilia School longer than the Israelites wandered in the desert! Mrs. Mitchell has served thousands of students and parents, hundreds of teachers and IHM Sisters, and dozens of priests. She has handled emergencies big and small, the surreal and the mundane with grace and generosity. I am grateful for your long tenure, attention to detail, amazing memory, and utter loyalty to the ideals of St. Cecilia School. She has lived more than 40% of our school's entire history. While she will not be at her desk every day, we are grateful that she will remain a presence in our school come September! May God bless her with a joyful and healthy retirement!

Second, I wanted to update you on Father Callahan, who has been facing

some health issues. Father was hospitalized with pneumonia on August 11th. While there, the physicians discovered an infection and a few other matters of concern. These are all behind him now, thank God, and he is on the path to healing. He has been moved to a rehab facility to regain his strength, and Fr Phong and I are anxious for his return to the Rectory. He is grateful for your prayers, cards, and expressions of support.

Third, I am grateful to those who have stepped forward to volunteer for the many new ways of serving at Saint Cecilia. I have four volunteers to help with gardening. There were thirty people present for last week's Blessing Bags (including many young people). Two new people are helping with our Funeral Planning Team, and two people have offered to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. Thank you for being part of this awesome gathering that is Saint Cecilia! Looking for a way to serve? Contact any of the staff or me. We will help you find a place!




Pilgrimages

Saint Cecilia had 588 parishioners complete the **DMI survey in Lent 2025** (we had 399 participants in 2022 when it was first taken). Over the summer, we will share “the results” of the survey. Father Chris, the Next Generation Parish Team, the Parish Staff, and others will begin reviewing the results to set new goals for our Parish Pastoral Plan for 2026-2029. There will be listening sessions for the whole parish in the Fall to gain more feedback and ideas as we move forward, guided by the Holy Spirit!

The first set of data we will review is called the **Four Factors for a Thriving Parish**. These data points, based on research with parishes across the United States, help us be a “thriving”

parish, leading others to Christ and living as authentic missionary disciples. The four areas are: **Leadership, Sunday Experience, Spiritual Practices, and Missionary Impulse**.

The final area to review is **Missionary Impulse** (*the willingness of our Parish to go out to others*). We have made some improvements, but this is an area that we (like most Catholics) have much to learn and develop.

- ◆ I invited someone to a parish activity increased from 41% to 72% (for inviting someone at least once).
- ◆ I invited someone to Mass increased from 52% to 70% (for

inviting someone at least once).


- ◆ Like in 2022, 13% of the parish have invited someone to consider the priesthood or religious life.
- ◆ I have answered a spiritual question of another person increased from 79% to 83%
- ◆ I volunteered to serve another (at least once a month) increased from 25% to 32%.
- ◆ I shared the story of Jesus with someone (at least once a month) increased from 24% to 29%.






