

**NEW PARISHIONERS** ~ Call the Parish Office for an appointment to register.

**MOVING** ~ Please notify the Parish Office with any changes to your home address or when household members move to another residence.

**BAPTISM** ~ Second, third and fourth Sunday of month at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

**MARRIAGE** ~ Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Call the Parish Office for an appointment. All scheduling considerations, including the initial date selection and any alterations, must be discussed with a Priest.

Message from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Poor Jeremiah! God called him to be a prophet. He served God faithfully for forty years. People tried to kill him multiple times, including his being thrown into a cistern in our first reading this weekend. He was run out of many towns and hated. What was his horrible crime? He asked people to repent of their idol worship and to worship the one, true God. In the time of Jeremiah, the idols were often literal carvings that people created and assigned divinity status. In addition, they worshipped the gods of their neighbors, especially Baal. Again and again, the God of Israel demonstrated that these idols were false and powerless. Still, the people returned to them seeking protection, pleasure, and, most often, control over a given situation.

What about you? Do you have idols? I am not thinking of a carving or Buddha, a lucky charm you take to Bingo (although each of these

would be a problem as well). Rather, I want you to examine the things that prevent you from fully surrendering to God and His plan for you. Perhaps a resentment or hatred towards someone. Perhaps a pursuit of pleasure in alcohol, drugs, gambling, sports, TV or social media. Perhaps it is your job and you are seeking promotion in your career. Perhaps it is trying to control another person or a situation with your family. While none of these things is evil in itself necessarily, each could become an idol if we allowed it. Each could keep us from knowing the Lord, loving the Lord, and serving the Lord.

Make some time to be with the Lord and allow Him to reveal any idols to you. If something is revealed, and you decide to come after me and through me into a cistern like they did to Jeremiah, you will have to wait as I leave for Scotland on Sunday evening. Be assured of my prayers in my absence. Father Phong and our wonderful staff will be available for any pastoral needs. I am most grateful for their competency and generosity.


