**BAPTISM** ~ Second, third and fourth Sunday of month at 12:15pm. Arrangements must be made at least two weeks prior to the Baptism. Attendance at a Pre-Jordan class is required for first time parents and the godparents are also welcome. Please register for class by contacting the Rectory at 215-725-1240. The selected godparents must be fully initiated Roman Catholics, in good standing with the Church, and at least 16 years old. A baptized non-Catholic Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness," provided there is a Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian Witness.

Message from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Blessed Labor Day weekend! Where has the time gone? I am sure you are as shocked as I am that schools open this week (if not already opened). Please pray for our teachers and young people, as well as our parents, as they adjust to the new schedule. Be careful driving through the neighborhood, too!

As we celebrate Labor Day, I believe it is vital that we recall the significant contribution of the Catholic Church to labor movements across the world. The most foundational Catholic document on labor is Rerum Novarum, meaning "of new things", issued by Pope Leo XIII in 1891 (our current Pope took

the name Leo in honor of this Pope Leo). It addresses the social and economic issues arising from the Industrial Revolution, particularly the exploitation of the working class. The encyclical advocates for the rights of workers, including the right to a just wage, safe working conditions, and the right to form unions. It also rejects both socialism and unbridled capitalism as solutions to the problems of the era, advocating for a middle ground that respects both capital and labor. Subsequent popes and conferences of bishops have issued additional documents, but none as robust as Rerum Novarum.

One comment by Pope Leo XIII is just as relevant today as it was in 1891: "The great mistake made in regard to the matter now under consideration is to take up with the notion that class is naturally hostile to class, and that the wealthy and the

working men are intended by nature to live in mutual conflict. So irrational and so false is this view that the direct contrary is the truth. . . . Each needs the other: capital cannot do without labor, nor labor without capital." (Par 19) The devil loves to divide. As we approach Labor Day, let us commit to ending the "us" vs. "them" thinking and seek to build the bridges needed for the human family. We need each other!

Please join us for Mass at 8:30am on Monday (Labor Day). There is much to pray for as many are looking for work. In addition, remember that the 6:30am Mass returns on Tuesday. Can you try and make a Mass during the week? I know it is a sacrifice but the graces received will be worth it!




Most stories about St. Maximilian Kolbe end when he steps forward to take the place of a condemned man in Auschwitz. Our story begins there.

In *Triumph of the Heart*, Kolbe enters the starvation bunker alongside nine condemned men and fights to forge a brotherhood of hope from their suffering and despair. St. Maximilian Kolbe was a Renaissance



man—a friar, a founder, a creator. He built a thriving friary, launched a magazine that reached millions, pioneered advancements in modern press technology, and even organized the first public fire station run by a religious order. But when faced with a truly apocalyptic war, Kolbe showed us something even greater: that Christian love can conquer the deepest horrors of the human condition. In the face of unimaginable suffering, Kolbe didn't retreat—he stepped forward, offering his life to save another.


