



### Thoughts on Stewardship: Seven Social Sins

The concept of seven deadly sins emerged during the Middle Ages. The sins are: lust, gluttony, greed, sloth, wrath, envy, and pride. But several years ago, a Vatican official revised the list, suggesting a list of seven social sins which also hurt people and which are more in time with modern life. The seven social sins are: creating poverty, excessive wealth, polluting the environment, contributing to widening the divide between the rich and the poor, bioethical violations, morally dubious experiments such as embryonic stem cell research, and drug use.

We are called to conversion with traditional deadly sins and with these sins. God has a path out of these sins. We are called to trust that God created each of us to do something as part of His plan for the world and to trust that God will provide the means for me to do it. We are called to do something beautiful for God.

How is God calling YOU to overcome these sins in YOUR life and the world you encounter each day? How can YOU use YOUR gifts to serve others, care for the poor and make the world good?


