*Message from the Pastor*




Dear Friends in Christ,

Sister Catherine met with parents and friends of our school earlier this week to review the school's safety plans and continue to brainstorm so that we adhere to best practices in our School. These same measures will be applied to our Religious Education Program when it meets on Sundays. Our recent additions of secure entryways and security cameras have certainly been a great help!

I am aware that some have safety and security concerns for the Church, as well. We have added cameras. We will install new doors in the months to come. ## **Thoughts on Stewardship:**

In 1937, a 45 year-old French woman named Jeanne Jugan decided to devote her life to God and prayer. Shortly after she and two companions rented a small attic apartment, she met a blind elderly widow with no one to care for her. Jeanne brought the woman home and gave her her own bed. Soon other elderly ladies in similar circumstances joined them. To support the women and themselves, Jeanne and her companions took in washing and mending to pay the bills.

On December 8, 1842, Sr. Jeanne and her companions took religious vows, establishing the Little Sisters of the Poor. Sr. Jeanne was chosen as mother superior. Sadly, a priest who was friends with them claimed he was the founder and took over the congregation. Sr. Jeanne humbly stepped aside for eleven years. She trusted God, even in those most difficult times. In time, the truth set them all free and she was canonized a saint in 2009.

At times, we share our gifts in beautiful ways, but others "do us wrong". Maybe out of jealousy or their own pride, the good work gets attacked. The devil is always busy.
