

*Message from the Pastor*



Dear Friends in Christ,

We join other Christians in praying for the souls in purgatory. We are not simply remembering those who died with gratitude, we are also praying that God have mercy on their souls, burn away any attachment to sin, and welcome them into glory.

As we pray for the dead, we also seek to prepare for our own death. I invite you to join me this Wednesday (or Saturday) and next week for Eternal Rest - Dying Well. It is not so much about the practical things like wills, funerals and cemeteries like in the past. This is about spiritual preparations for what awaits us all. The video teaching, along with our discussion and prayer, will lessen our fear and worry as we await death. Join me. If you have questions, call the Parish Office.


### Thoughts on Stewardship: Life with Principles

What principles have you built your life around? There's a difference between acting on principles and simply the desire to do right. Most people sincerely want to do the right thing. But it can be difficult during the wind and rain of a crisis. That's when they need a solid foundation built on principles. So what about your foundation?

Do you have principles about forgiveness? Jesus gave the gift of forgiveness, but do you forgive only when you feel like it? Or do you have basic principles about forgiveness that will overcome your feelings in individual instances?

Do you have principles about not talking negatively about people behind their backs? Do you have a principle about prayer? Do I have a principle about generosity? Do you give when and where you feel like it, or do you have a principle, perhaps, of giving a percentage of my income to God and to those in need?

So what principles have you built into your life? Are you on sandy ground so that when the rains fall, the torrents come, and the winds lash against the house, you fall apart? Or is your life solidly built on rock, putting into practice the things that you as a baptized person believe?




