



Dear Friends in Christ,

Like most of you, I have members of my family and close friends who will not worship the Lord this Christmas. And if they do make it on Christmas, they will likely not be in Church the following Sunday (or any Sunday until Easter). Some have been hurt by someone at the Parish in some way. Some disagree or misunderstand some teaching of Jesus or the Church. Some are lazy and choose to use Sunday to catch up on housework and errands. Some have just slowly drifted for no reason at all.

It seems that all have one thing in common: they are not currently in love with Jesus Christ. That might sound harsh. But I believe it to be true. Perhaps they were and the love grew cold. Maybe they never had the personal relationship that inspires lifelong worship. Perhaps when they were "going to Church" they were just going through the motions for someone else. In many cases, the person has never had someone share with them the Good News that they are loved by God; that God has a plan for them that includes the forgiveness of sin and leading them in a wonderful way towards peace.

God needs us - each of us - to continue to be good witnesses to the faith. To never be afraid of sharing the difference that Jesus Christ makes in our life. God needs witnesses. It is not easy. But it is necessary.

Please join us in praying for our loved ones and friends who need to come home to the Church. We will pray in Church from 6 pm to 7pm on Monday, December 22<sup>nd</sup>. At the same time, Fr. Phong and I are available for Confessions. Lots of grace will be flowing! Be there to receive some of it!


