

Dear Friends in Christ,

Earlier this week Fr. Phong, George Warren (who coordinates our O.C.I.A.) and I mailed letters to 180 people who are married to Catholics registered at St. Cecilia but who are not themselves Catholic. The purpose of the letter was singular: to invite them to consider being baptized or received into full communion with the Catholic Church. O.C.I.A. stands for the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. For years it was known as R.C.I.A. which stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults but the "Rite" was expanded to "Order" because "Rite" only covered the actual rituals whereby one was welcomed into the Church and "Order" implies the entire process. Either way, it is the way we form and welcome new Catholics who are not children.

Perhaps your spouse or a family member received the letter; encourage her or him to be open to the possibility. Perhaps you have a friend or co-worker who is searching for meaning and purpose in life; tell her or him that you have a place where they can ask questions and explore these questions. Perhaps you are reading this and are not yet a Catholic or feel as though you do not know your faith as you would like to; consider

joining us on Tuesday nights starting in early October. Call Fr. Phong, George or myself at 215-725-1240 and we will get you started!

I know God has great plans for our faith community of St. Cecilia. I know God wants to use YOU to impact the lives of others. I need YOU to help spread the word and invite others. It is YOUR call as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Thank you for all you have done and are doing for the Lord!



The Secret Prayer: Did you know there are some 'secret' prayers at Mass? If you watch very closely, you'll notice that the priest is moving his lips and praying some prayers very, very quietly during the Preparation of the Gifts. The rubrics indicate that the priest should pray them 'secreto', which is translated as 'inaudibly' or 'secret.' But there's really no secret, because the prayers are printed in the Roman Missal or other worship resources for the whole world to see. And even though the rubrics indicate that the priest is to pray these prayers, there is absolutely no reason why you can't do that too! As the priest pours wine and a little water into the chalice, he prays quietly: "By the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity." Then the priest bows profoundly and says quietly: "With humble spirit and contrite heart may we be accepted by you, O Lord, and may our sacrifice in your sight this day be pleasing to you, Lord God." Finally, as he washes his hands he prays, "Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin."




