

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Birthday, Church! 1,992 years ago, the Holy Spirit fell on perhaps one hundred Christians, and the Church was launched into the world. The Holy Spirit has transformed lives on every continent, in every nation, and among every tribe and ethnic group. The Holy Spirit's mission remains the same: to make Jesus present in our lives since Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life!

As we gather, 5,774 miles from the Upper Room where Pentecost took place, the same Holy Spirit wants to continue the mission of making Jesus present in our lives. This happens through Jesus' presence in Word and Sacrament. This happens through Jesus' presence through other people. This happens through Jesus' gentle movement through our times of quiet prayer and reflection. It happens each day in our Parish Church, in your home, and so many other places.

Please be open to the movement of God's Holy Spirit. Please pray: Come, Holy Spirit. 
All are welcome to join us from June 23rd to 27th 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm each night in the Auditorium.


