St. Margaret of Scotland (1045-1093) was the great-niece of St. Edward the Confessor. She was a Saxon princess, raised in Hungary in exile. Returning to England, she had to flee once again after the Battle of Hastings,

to the court of Malcolm, the King of Scotland, whom she married in 1069 and had eight children. The country was blessed by her holy life and by her deeds of charity for the next thirty years. Her most remarkable virtue was love of neighbor, particularly love toward the poor. Her alms supported countless unfortunates. She provided food for three hundred daily and shared in the work of serving them personally. Her feast day is **November 16**.
