Third Sunday of Easter May 4, 2025

A Word from Father Ed,

Dear Parishioner.

Happy Easter! I hope your Easter Season is going well. Our Gospel this weekend from John (Jn 21:1-19) offers us a few things to reflect and pray about. First, we hear Simon Peter say that he is going fishing. We recall that before Jesus called Simon Peter, he, as well as some of the other disciples were fishermen. This act of going fishing seems like Simon Peter is at a loss for what to do and so he reverts back to what he knows or what is comfortable to him. This is a cautionary scene for us because we know we are called to be and live as the new creations we've become in Christ through our Lenten journeys. However, there are moments where we will be tempted to revert and choose old and even sometimes bad habits or behaviors that we've worked so hard to leave behind. Thus, we should be aware of any reversion moment temptations that pop up in our lives. Also, in Simon Peter going fishing, this allows us to see that the disciples hadn't quite grasped the fullness of what the Resurrection means and so they're just kind of living their lives, so to speak. But we see the Lord call them once again. This reminds us to always keep unpacking what the Resurrection means for our lives as disciples – who we are, who we're called to be, how we're called to live. Lastly, we see Jesus ask Simon Peter if he loves Him not once but three times. Scholars suggest Jesus' threefold questioning of Simon Peter is an undoing of the threefold denial Simon Peter had during the time of Jesus' trial and Passion. This threefold action though, can remind us to always claim the love of Christ when the world may tempt us to deny our faith or otherwise.

Before I conclude my article, I want to make mention that this is my last bulletin article as your Presbyteral Moderator. Dc. Pete has most likely mentioned to the parish that he, along with myself and Fr. Rod Kreidler, have been working hard to make better arrangements to provide the best pastoral care for the parishes in the area. The result of these efforts is a new parochial vicar being assigned to the area and a change in leadership. Dc. Pete will remain as St. Stephen's Parish Life Coordinator (PLC) and Fr. Rod Kreidler will take over as Presbyteral Moderator effective June 1, 2025. This means my time with you will be coming to a conclusion at the end of the month. I thank everyone for the opportunity to get to know you, your prayers, and your support. Please know that you remain in my prayers!
