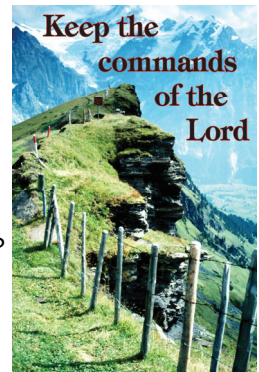

BBQ Dinner Sts. Cyril & Methodius

In case you didn't hear, the members of Sts. Cyril & Methodius voted to change back to a BBQ Dinner Drive-Thru. NO BAZAAR this year. So we will have 1/2 BBQ Chicken & Sausage Dinner Drive-Thru (1000 plates) plus seating will be available under the Pavilion to enjoy your meal and listen to the M&M Playboys, Bake Sale, Homemaker's Mart & Raffle. There will be a limited amount of meat sold by the pound at the pit.

Your HELP is needed in all of the areas above. First we need to get the word out as to what we are doing. The posters we printed up can be used—we just ask that you mark thru the things we are NOT doing: Auction, Game Booths, Silent Auction, Bingo, Concession Stand, Cole Slaw and the word BAZAAR. Patsy also printed corrected flyers that you can pick up in the back of the Church. Take a picture of the flyer and post it on your social media page. Great way to advertise!!!

After Mass each Sunday we will have a worksheet for you to sign up to help. Basically the dinner lasts from about 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. If WE ALL pitch in life will be great! Then we all help clean up and go home.

We are asking you to bake items for the Bake Sale. We will also have the Homemaker's Mart and are asking for canned goods, craft items, vegetables and plants. Get some of your items together, take a picture of them, and send to Patsy Pekar. She will put it on Facebook and website to show people what we will have.

Take time to sell those Raffle Tickets to family, friends and neighbors. Buy a few extra books yourself and increase your chance of winning...5 chances to win \$500 plus 12 more chances to win \$250 or less. We will also be selling them as people go through the dinner drive thru.

We will not make as much on this dinner as we do on the bazaar so we will need donations from each of you. Whatever you would have spend on the bazaar, please consider donating that amount to the Church. If you read the bulletin, you will notice that we barely meet out weekly goal. We need the support of all of our members.

There are only two fundraisers that the Church holds each year: The Turkey Dinner in March (which gathers funds for the Altar Society which in turn purchases liturgical supplies and offers student scholarships throughout the year) and the Bazaar which will only be a drive-thru dinner this year. EVERYONE in the parish should be involved especially the day of the Dinner, September 19th. It is also a great time to visit each other while you work. How often do we get to talk to each other? After Mass we all go our separate ways and seldom get to talk. You have a chance to MAKE MONEY for the Church and GET TO VISIT. STOP make excuses. You are part of the Church community so make plans to be there.

If you have already purchased or made items for the bazaar and have no place to store them, we can store them at the Church until next year's bazaar. Just let us know.

ANNUAL MISSION APPEAL: OUT OF AFRICA

We welcome Fr. Jerry Aman this weekend

Each year, our Archdiocese participates in the Missionary Cooperative Plan, which invites a missionary to preach at a parish for mission appeals. This plan provides the people of our Archdiocese the opportunity to increase their awareness of the vital mission work of the Church. **This year our appeal will be on the weekend of August 28th & 29th at all masses.** Fr. Jerry Aman is a Jesuit missionary who has been in Africa for the past 36 years. Originally an upstate New York farm boy, he attended a Jesuit school in Rochester, NY and joined the Jesuits at the age of 17. He served 27 years in Nigeria in several missions including parish work for 10 years, building the first Jesuit school in the Federal Capital Territory, and assistant to the Jesuit for the past nine years Provincial in Lagos. For the past nine years he was helping to form young Jesuits from 20 different African countries in the Jesuit School of Philosophy in Zimbabwe. He is presently on a Sabbatical for four months and will return to Nigeria where he will take up parish work in the parish where he first started in 1985.

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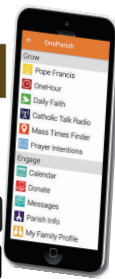
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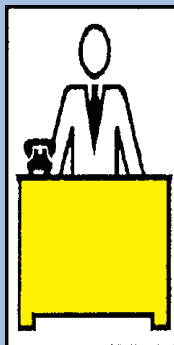
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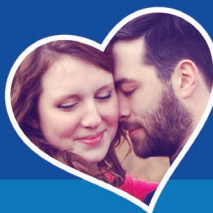
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
