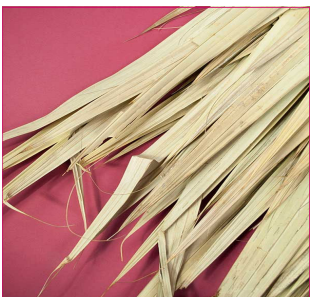
Thank you...

If you have dried-out palms from last year, you can return them to the Parish Office or give them to an usher after Mass. They will be burned on Ash Wednesday.

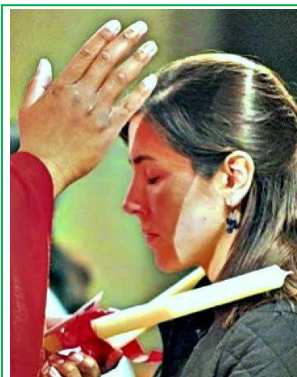

Friday, February 3rd is the Feast of St. Blaise. Catholics often participate in the tradition of having their throats blessed. To do this, the priest consecrates two candles, generally by a prayer, and then holds each in a crossed position on the throat of the person being blessed. At the same time, the following blessing is given:

"Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." Why does the blessing of the throat take place on St. Blaise Day? St. Blaise, a physician and bishop, asked God to cure a child who was choking to death on a fish bone and the child's life was saved. Thus, St. Blaise is the patron saint of healthy throats. Blessing of the throats will take place during all of the weekend Masses on Saturday, February 4th and Sunday, February 5th.

CAN YOU SERVE?

St. Michael's and Sts. Cyril & Methodius have a group of parishioners who help each Mass run smoothly by volunteering to serve as altar servers (***Sts. Cyril & Methodius is in desperate need of adult and children or young adult altar servers!***), Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion, lectors, ushers/greeters, and sacristans.

Please prayerfully consider volunteering as a Liturgical Minister. Contact either Parish Office and they will gladly set up a training session for you. **NOTE:** All current Liturgical Ministers are asked to update their contact information.

To inquire about being trained to serve in any ministry, please call either Parish Office. They can then set you up to be trained.

Chalice Ministry Has Resumed

We have resumed the practice of distributing Holy Communion from the chalice to the faithful.

"Drink from it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins."

— Matthew 26:28

Due to the understanding that some of the faithful may not be comfortable receiving Holy Communion under this form due to health concerns, Cardinal reminds us that, as always, reception of Holy Communion from the chalice is at the discretion of the communicant.

NO INTINCTION

Intinction is the **Eucharistic practice of partly dipping the consecrated bread**, or host, into the consecrated wine before consumption by the communicant.

This is not an acceptable practice of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston, and the Cardinal asks that intinction not be used as the normal method of distributing Holy Communion. The practice of receiving from the cup more effectively follows the Lord's instruction to "take and eat" and "take and drink." In NO case is the communicant to self-communicate (#50, Norms).
