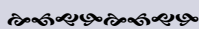

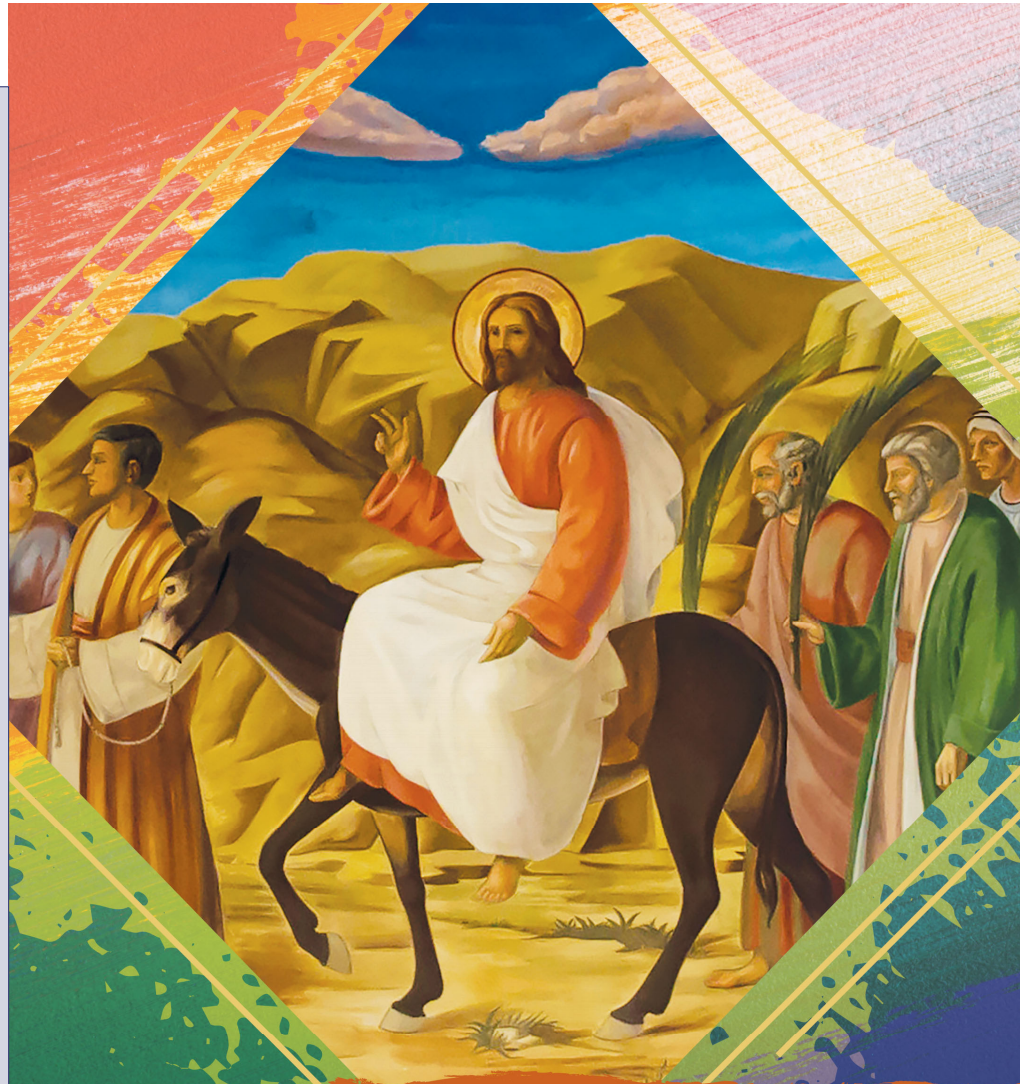

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ASSIST



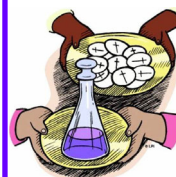

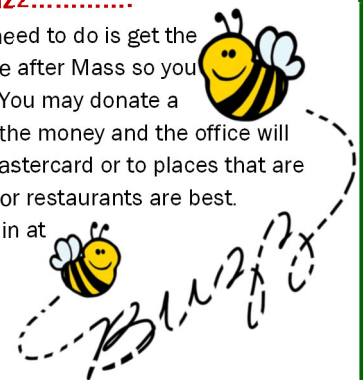
Sts. Cyril & Methodius Bazaar Buzz.....

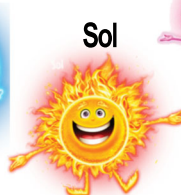

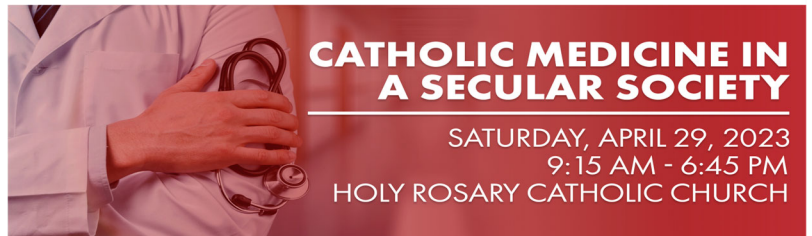
