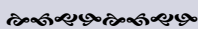

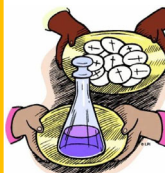
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ASSIST

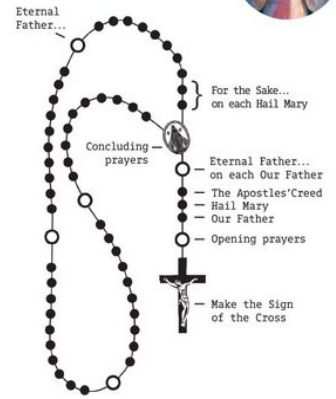
Hail Mary
