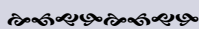

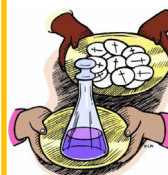
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ASSIST

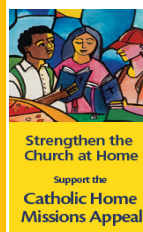

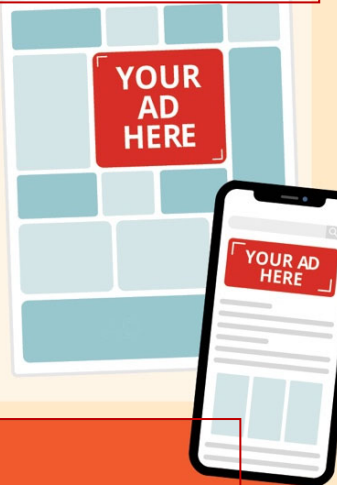

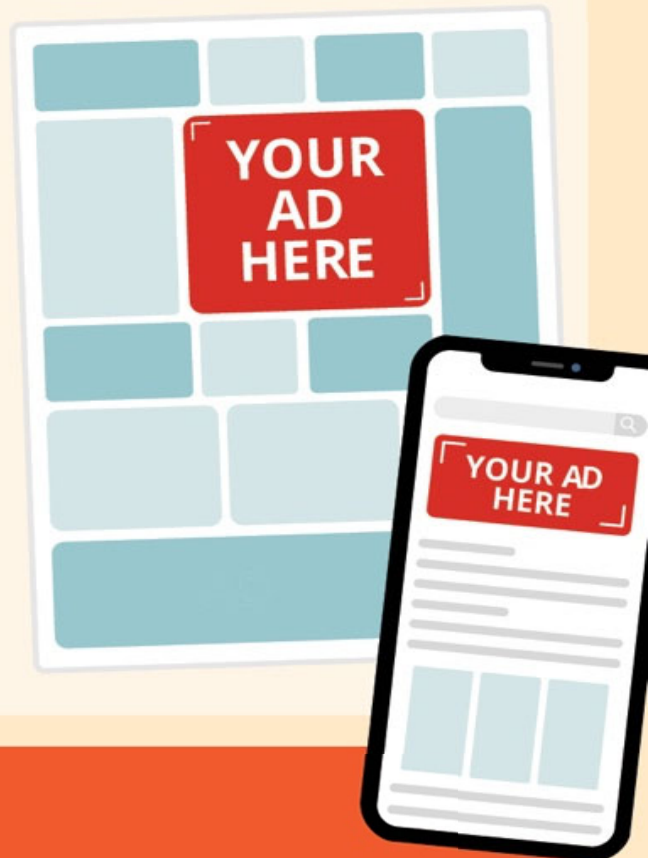
