SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE TRAINING

The Safe Environment compliance training and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in our Archdiocese. All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteer activities. Mandatory renewal training must be completed every five years and a new background check submitted before the five-year expiration of prior training. You may contact the parish office if you need the status of your training, forgot your login id, or need your password reset. If you have never taken the training, please create a login at the above address and follow the directions given. Remember, education is a key element of the Safe Environment Program.

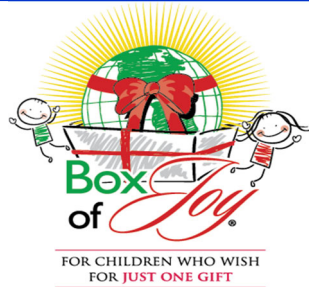
Sacramental Preparation Begins with a Family Retreat

Also keep in your prayers that we have a successful, fun and COOL bazaar.

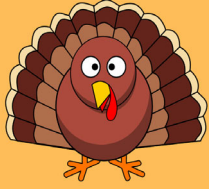
