GIFT IDEAS

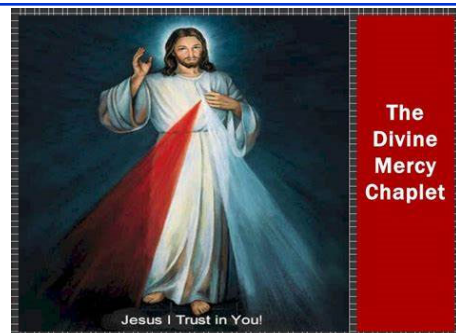
