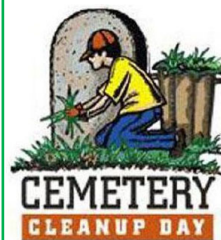

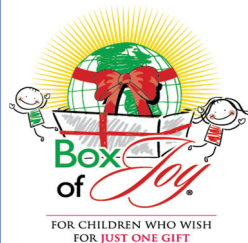
BOX OF JOY
