Message from Deacon Jason Sulak

I was raised in Louise, Texas and grew up farming rice with my family. I graduated from Louise High School and enlisted in the US Navy where I spent six years as a nuclear mechanic on a ballistic submarine. Upon receiving an honorable discharge, I went to college and received a B.S. in Physics from the University of Houston.

During college, while discerning a calling to the priesthood, I was set up on a blind date with my now wife, Chaille, and married her within a year. In November, we will celebrate our 28th Wedding Anniversary. We have six children ages 15 to 25.

We were parishioners at Holy Rosary in Rosenberg for 23 years. About 9 years ago, our then pastor, Fr. Bill Bartniski asked me to consider the diaconate. I began formation in 2015 and was ordained into the permanent diaconate of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston in February of 2021 with a M.A. in Pastoral Studies.
