Office of Child & Youth Protection

The Safe Environment compliance training and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in our Archdiocese. All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteer activities. Mandatory renewal training must be completed every five years and a new background check submitted before the five-year expiration of prior training. 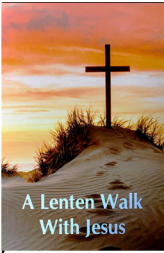

On January 22, 1973, THE United States Supreme Court rendered their decision in the Roe v. Wade case which effectively legalized abortion. The consequences of that decision have resulted in well over 62 million abortions. On June 24, 2022, the current United States Supreme
