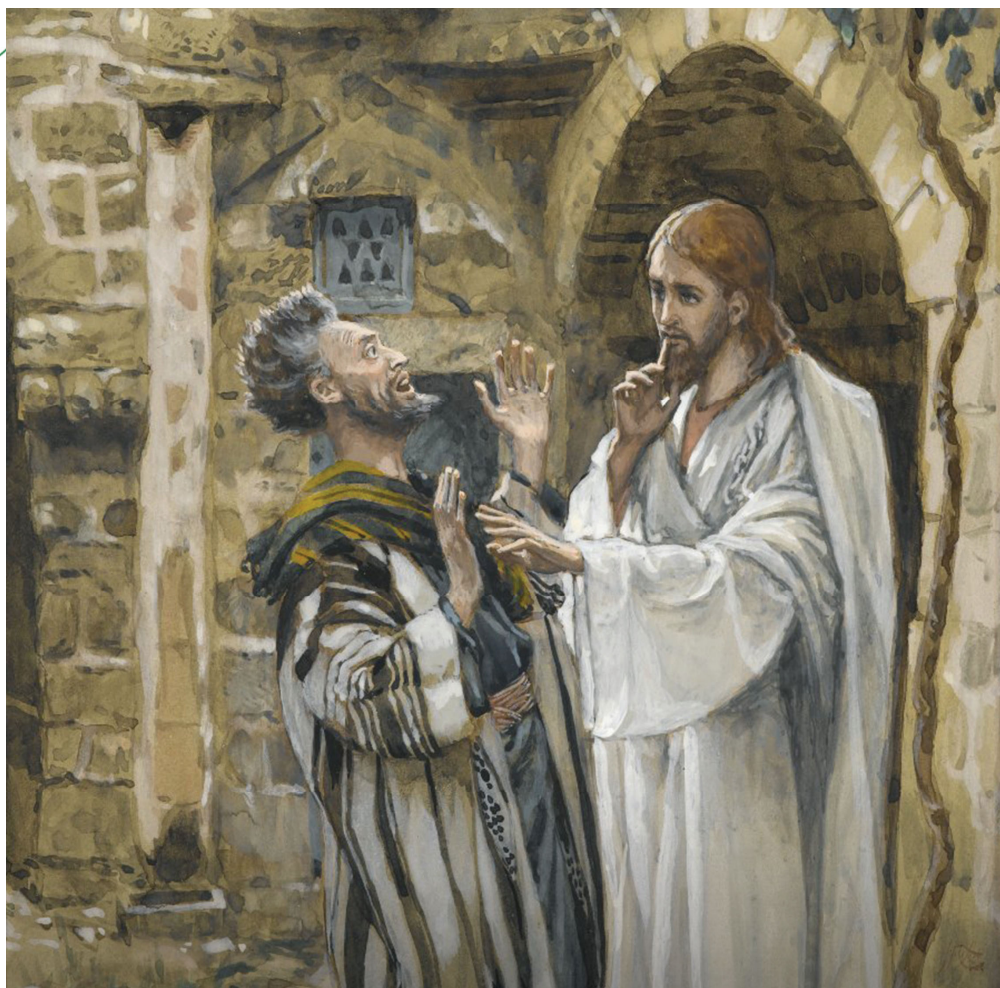

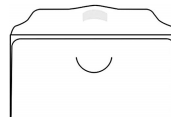

NEW ORGAN PROJECT AT STS. CYRIL & METHODIUS

We are embarking on a program to enrich the lives of our congregation and friends through the beauty of a new Rodgers organ at Sts. Cyril & Methodius. The current organ was purchased in the 70's and has several issues that need to be addressed; however, this instrument is obsolete and parts are almost if not impossible to obtain that would bring it back to perfect performing condition.

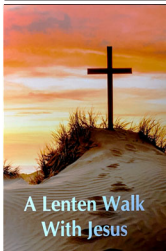


The new model of organ (Rodgers Inspire Series 233) that we are wanting to purchase has the ability for the organist to record music into the organ, comes with 350 pre-recorded music for those times when an organist might not be available, allows for an improved speaker sound system if we choose this option, and it will give the ability to store registration settings externally on a USB device.

All members, organizations and friends are invited to participate in this worthy and lasting project by donating towards the purchase of this organ. The Rodgers Inspire 233 model costs around \$39,000.00. Two optional speaker systems can be added for an additional cost.

**TO ALL PARISH MEMBERS, ORGANIZATIONS AND FRIENDS OF
STS. CYRIL & METHODIUS CHURCH:**

We are embarking on a program to enrich the lives of our congregation and friends through the beauty of a new Rodgers organ. This instrument will greatly enhance our music program and add to our worship experience.

Our current organ was purchased in the 70's and has several issues that need to be addressed; however, this instrument is obsolete and parts are almost if not impossible to obtain that would bring it back to perfect performing condition. Our organists have made a list of things that are wrong with our current organ:

1. The power switch doesn't work to turn the organ on/off.
2. Key settings randomly do not work.
3. Lower level keyboard needs tuning (it is offkey).
4. Foot pedals are sticking or have no sound.
5. Not all the lights are lit to read the sheet music.
6. The transpose buttons don't light up or sync up.
7. There is concern over the safety and wiring of the old organ.

The new organ we want to purchase would address the above issues and in addition:

1. It will give the ability for the organist to record music into the organ.
2. Comes with 350 pre-recorded music for those times when an organist might not be available.
3. Allows for an improved speaker sound system if we choose this option.
4. It will give the ability to store registration settings externally on a USB device.

All members, organizations and friends are invited to participate in this worthy and lasting project by donating towards the purchase of this organ. The organ we want to purchase is the Inspire 233 model and the cost would be around \$39,000.00 It can be equipped with either of the two speaker options for an extra charge listed below:

1. Two channel external audio system—\$2,900.00 (includes two large full range speakers, amplifiers, installation).
2. Six channel external audio system—\$5,200.00 (includes 4 mid and upper range speakers, two subwoofer speakers, 3 two channel amplifiers, installation).

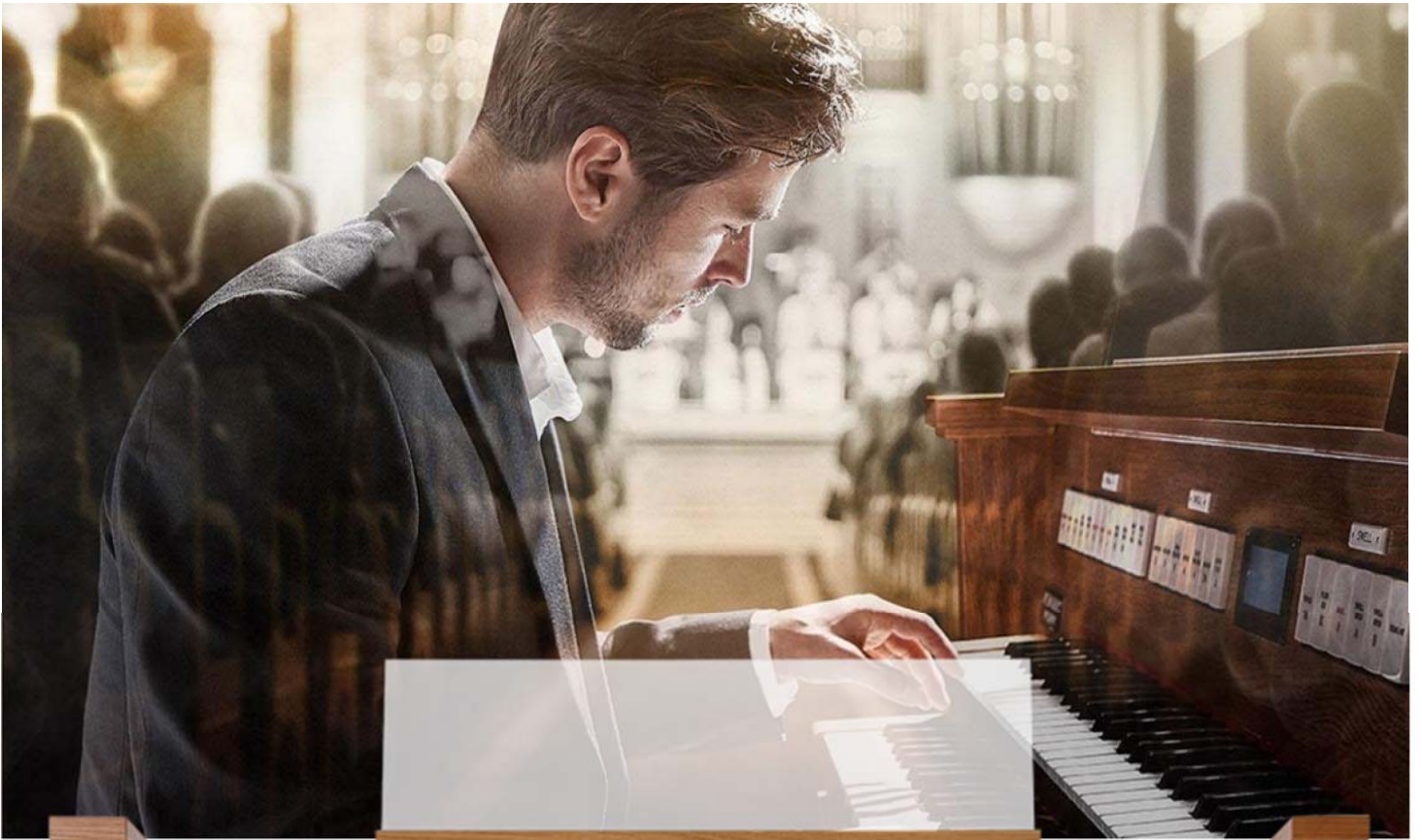


