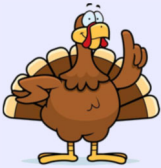

SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE TRAINING

Please check you may be expired or close to being expired!

"Protecting Vulnerable Adults" is for those who have completed the 5-year "Safe Haven" training. This training is an online training, and it is approximately 20 minutes in duration. The training may be completed two (2) months before your Safe Haven expiration date.

The Safe Environment compliance training and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in our Archdiocese. All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment or volunteer activities. Mandatory renewal training must be completed every five years and a new background check submitted before the five-year expiration of prior training. You may contact the parish office if you need the status of your training, forgot your login id, or need your password reset. If you have never taken the training, please create a login at the above address and follow the directions given. Remember, education is a key element of the Safe Environment Program.

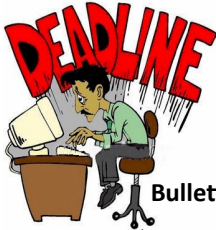
