Office of Child and Youth Protection

SAFE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

The Archdiocese strives to implement policies, procedures, and training that may help protect the safety of children, young people and vulnerable adults who are enrolled in our parish schools, religious education classes, and other programs. Priests, deacons, clergy, employees, and volunteers are called at all times to engage in Christ-Centered and professional behavior. The background screening and Safe Environment training of all priests, deacons, clergy, employees, volunteers, groups, movements, and organizations is a requirement of the Archdiocese and assists in upholding our Safe Environment Policies.

Abuse of children is immoral and reprehensible and will not be tolerated by the Archdiocese. The law requires that anyone who has cause to believe that a child's physical or mental health or welfare has been or may be adversely affected by abuse or neglect must report his or her suspicions to the Texas Department of Human Services or a local state law enforcement agency. When Archdiocesan personnel are involved in child abuse, the Archdiocese's ability to carry out its mission is undermined.

All Archdiocesan personnel must comply with applicable laws regarding incidents of actual or suspected child abuse including abuse involving child on child conduct.

Failure to report suspected physical or mental abuse or neglect of a child in Texas is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both.

PERMISSION TO MAKE A REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED OR EXPECTED. ERR ON THE SIDE OF MAKING A GOOD FAITH REPORT RATHER THAN FAILING TO DO SO. Use the following link to access the Office of Child and Youth Protection reporting requirements: www.archgh.org/ocvp

Education is a key element of the Safe Environment program. All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment, volunteer, or participate with ministries, groups, movements, and organizations. In addition, the mandatory renewal training must be completed every 5 years and a new background check submitted before the 5 year expiration of prior training. **The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston Safe Environment compliance training and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston.**

Everyone who is involved in any organizations (extraordinary [liturgical] ministries, SVDP, Catholic Daughters, Bible Study, Altar Society, Funeral Dinners, Bazaars, Money Counters, OLOG, Youth Ministry, Elementary Faith Formation, Finance & Pastoral Councils, Adoration, Building Committee or any and all other committees) or volunteer at St. Michael the Archangel and/or Sts. Cyril & Methodius is required to take the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston Child and Youth Protection Safe Environment Training and submit for a background check every 5 years. This is required for any person who is over the age of 18. For those who have never taken the training it will take around 70 minutes to complete and you must consent to have a background check. This training can be taken at your own pace. Those who are coming up on their 5-year training renewal will need to take a new training called "Protecting Vulnerable Adults" and this training is 20 minutes long and you must consent for a background check as well since you are renewing.

If you have never taken the training and need help, please contact Veronica Kresse in the St. Michael's Parish Office. If you do not have a computer at home we can set you up here at the office. Please call the office to set up an appointment. You will need your driver's license and social security number for a background check. The office is here to help so everyone can follow the diocesan guidelines for employment or volunteering in our churches. If you have forgotten your login information, please DO NOT create a new login because this creates problems and duplicates. Please reach out to Veronica Kresse directly and she can reset your password and give you your username login information. To login to the website, please go to <https://galvestonhouston.cmgconnect.org>. Failure to comply will result in you NOT being able to volunteer. Veronica Kresse is the coordinator for both parishes, if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to her. She can be reached Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m. till 2:30 p.m. at 979-793-4477 or you can email her at veronica_kresse@yahoo.com.

NOTE: You may have taken a training years ago called "VIRTUS", this is not the same program. You must retake this new one and renew it every 5 years.

***NOTE: For Damon Parishioners**

DO NOT create a new profile if you already had one in the past! Also, please make sure you scroll down the list of parishes and find "Sts. Cyril & Methodius-Damon, TX".
