St. Michael's Cemetery Marker Cleanup Day

The Needville Knights of Columbus will be conducting a St. Michael's Cemetery Marker Cleanup Day, Saturday, October 19th.

We will be cleaning the moss and lichen that darkens the markers. We will avoid deep cleaning some of the larger stones that are more fragile and are in risk of breaking further.

We will be using a product called D2 which is the approved product by the Texas Historical Commission and the National Parks Service. It is safe to be used around people, pets and the environment. We will not be using any power washers or metal brushes.

Work will begin at 9 a.m. and continue until 12 noon.

Adults and teenagers are encouraged to help in this worthwhile project. This would be a great opportunity for our young adults to participate in a community volunteer project. It is also a great way of honoring those who have gone before us. The work takes minimal effort but produces incredible results.

Sts. Cyril & Methodius will be celebrating its 100th year anniversary on Sunday, May 4, 2025 with a Mass at 10:00 a.m. with Daniel Cardinal DiNardo. More details will follow as they are planned.

The History Committee is wanting to put a booklet together with facts, stories and pictures about our church. Forms can be found in the back of the church for you to write down your stories. Also, you can turn in your photos for us to scan. We will need these stories and photos as soon as possible so we have enough time to put the booklet together and printed.

SO MANY STORIES WAITNG TO BE HEARD

Please send in your stories. What were the Mass times through the church's 100 year history? Has it always been 8:30 a.m. Sunday Mass, or was there a time when parishioners had a choice of several Masses to attend? Ladies, do you remember covering your head with a mantilla; and did you own several colors? These are just hints to spark your memory. We especially need to know the names of the men and women who grew up in our parish and have become priest, nuns, sisters, brothers, religious.

Sts. Cyril & Methodius parishioners, we need your stories and pictures.

The Church's 100-year Anniversary will be upon us very quickly and the Historical Committee needs your input. The booklet will be lacking your entries. We hope to be able to publish this booklet for a nominal fee so that each family can take one home. So far three stories have been added into the story section of the booklet. It was noticed that the tiniest of detail can hold a wealth of information. Who knew there was a choir loft in the original church? What about Father Pekar taking the altar boys to the beach? Did you know the church bell was rung five minutes before Mass started?

To date we have received only three stories. Please don't wait until the last minute. Time is needed to type them in the manner which is acceptable for the publisher. And time is needed for turnaround once it is sent to the publisher.

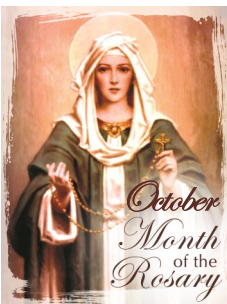
