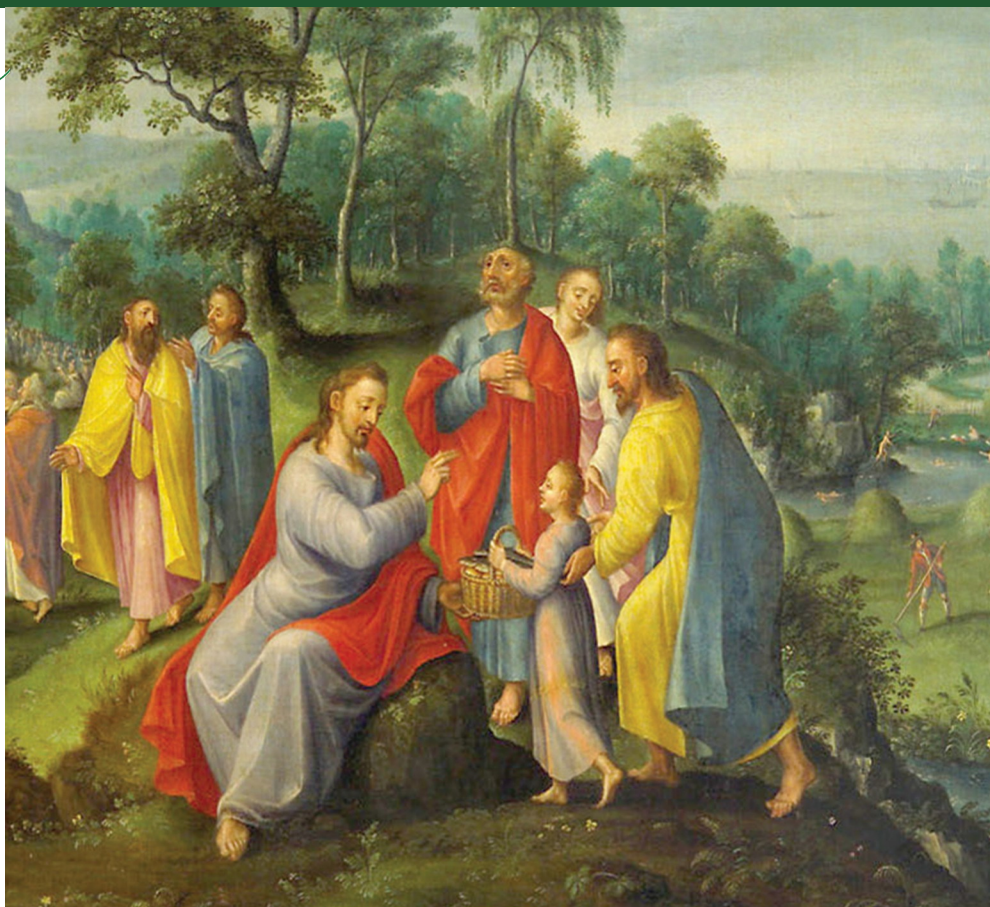

MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2026

It is an ancient and noble practice to pray for the living and the dead at Mass. The greatest and most powerful prayer we have is the Mass, since the fruits of the Mass are the very fruits of Jesus' redemption made present to us. Therefore, so many of us seek to book a Mass intention for our loved ones.

Canon Law requires that only one intention be taken per Mass. The Mass Intention book for January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 is **now open**. One Intention will be taken per Mass, published in the bulletin and read out loud during the Prayers of the Faithful.

In order to accommodate the numerous Mass requests in a reasonable and fair manner the following parish policies are in place:

St. Michael's: Allows 4 weekday masses and 4 weekend masses per person (one Sunday mass is always designated for Parish Family).

Sts. Cyril & Methodius: Allows 1 weekday mass and 1 Sunday mass per person (one Sunday Mass a month is always designated for Parish Family). This is due to the limited amount of masses held at Sts. Cyril & Methodius.

Queen of Peace Rosary

Held in the Sts. Cyril & Methodius Chapel on the 25th of every month at 10 a.m.

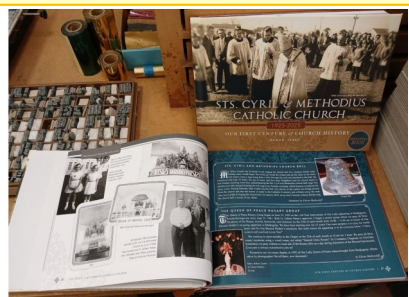

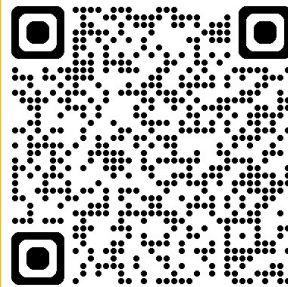

Providing Warmth to over
1 Million Kids Since 2009



This week at True North Totally Catholic VBS, your kids are learning that Jesus is a friend we can trust. We are called to be friends to others, too – especially people in need. One way we are encouraging kids to answer God's call is by participating in our VBS Outreach Project.

It is estimated that about 27 million children in the United States live in low income families that might have trouble providing warm coats for their children in winter.

OSV's True North Totally Catholic VBS is partnering with the Knights of Columbus to provide warm coats to children in need. During the week, your kids will be encouraged to bring in monetary donations (anything from a handful of coins to a check). The donations will go toward purchasing new, zero-degree rated coats for children in need.

At the end of the week, the total collection will be announced.

Coats for Kids BY THE NUMBERS

The Knights of Columbus distribute coats in all **50** states and **10** Canadian provinces.

1,500 councils participate in annual distributions.

Approximately **200,000** coats are distributed each year.

\$21 can provide a warm winter coat for a child in need.

\$248 can provide 12 coats for young boys and girls

\$305 can provide 12 coats for teens.

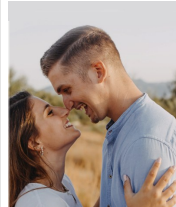
