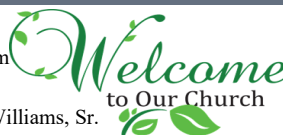


Special Collection This Weekend


Some of the concerns are:

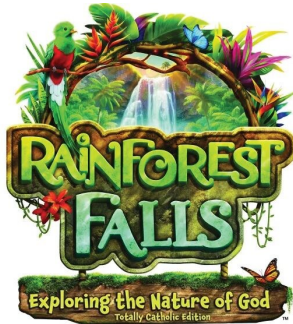

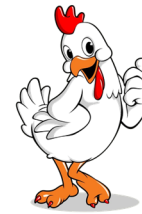
