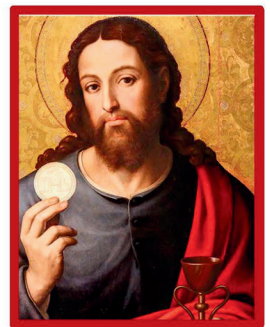
In this 5-session video-based study **Dr. Edward Sri** explores the biblical roots of the Liturgy and reveals what it all means and why it all matters.
