Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord



It was during the fourth century in Jerusalem that Christians first starting using palm branches in commemoration of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. Today, we continue to use palms in churches on this Sunday, Catholic and Protestant alike. Palm Sunday is also known as Passion Sunday, because we hear an account of the passion of Jesus Christ

during the liturgy.

Worship on this day, highlights the fundamental truth in the observance: Jesus Christ died for everyone. He did not die on a cross for just Catholics, or just Orthodox, or just Protestants. Whether one acknowledges it or not, he was crucified for all those who are born of man. Today, we rejoice not just for what he has done for us but also for what he has done for all of creation.
