Brother Knights,

Meeting this Thursday with a meal preceding the meeting. It is hard to imagine that our fraternal year is hardly a month old and so much has already been done. Our presentation of the relics had more than 65 participants with Knights coming from several neighboring parishes. We had at least 26 Knights volunteer for the Fire Department Fundraiser and that money will bring needed educational resources to our youth. We recruited 2 new members. We collected coats for kids which will be distributed by councils in our district. Let us continue to accelerate our efforts.

Several VERY important topics are coming up on Thursday, I particularly ask all officers to attend. First is a topic raised in the July meeting, and then discussed in the officer's meeting. The officers are recommending we donate \$5000 to KC State Charities for the sole and expressed purpose of disaster relief in Central Texas. This is being recommended because it's the best way to deploy 100% directly to the area councils, parishes, and families impacted by the floods last month. Second, the Hall is in much need of repairs and remodeling. A committee of Columbus Club Officers and other stakeholders have been collecting ideas and bids and believe they have a path that provides a future for the hall as ambitious as the last major remodel in the 1980's. Details can be presented out by CC officers, but there is a unanimous agreement to move forward to expose the original ceiling. When this will be done and who does the work is up to the Columbus Club. In order for the work to be done, the Council officers recommend loaning the money to the Columbus Club. To move forward with this action we will ask the Council to approve the "not to exceed" amount of the loan to be paid back in a term of 20 years. This loan will not impact our planned charitable giving or scheduled programs.

Lastly, we need to approve a donation to the Needville Little League and the purchase of some equipment for our youth programs (both fall under the \$500 threshold) and will be part of regular business.

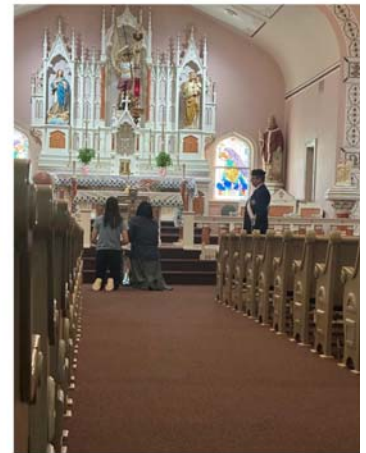
