Reflection of the Week by Fr. Leo Ahanotu

I want to start by reminding us of one of the prayers we say during the Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent; "By your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world." The prayer is a summary of Jesus' Passion as an act of love for humanity. We shall listen to the Passion of Christ this Sunday. We shall hear the hardheartedness and meanness of the various groups of people who wanted Him dead and the diverse role they played. We shall listen to His condemnation, how He was stripped, whipped, nailed on the Cross, His death, and His completion of His work of redemption by His resurrection. As we listen to the Passion story, let us remember that the purpose of that story is not to tell us how Jesus suffered but what made Him suffer - His love of His sheep, you and I, whom He loves so much and had to come into the world to suffer and die for our salvation. The church does not accidentally call the Friday He died a GOOD FRIDAY instead of a bad Friday. The center of the Passion story is CHRIST's love for us. The love that made Him forgive His executioners. The love that made Him forgive and allow the criminal who was crucified with Him to escort Him to Heaven due to His repentance, as said by Fulton Sheen. A dying woman I visited in a hospital was smiling and told me that she offers her sufferings and her eventual death from cancer for the Lord's forgiveness of her sins and those of others. This woman challenges us to be imitators of Christ and transform sufferings into love and make suffering a HOLY act for our salvation and the salvation of others. She challenges us to be our brothers' and sisters' caretakers and evaluate every experience with a mind that wants to unite with Christ and seeks heaven. Fr. Leo
