July 9, 2023 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our gospel passage today is a presentation of two accents or emphasis: the accent of authority (Matt. 11:25-27) and the accent of compassion (28-30). Jesus came as a humble messiah, poor king, lowly and peaceful; though victorious and triumphant, he came riding on a donkey, on a colt (Zec. 9:9). He came not like the earthly kings who rode majestically on horses. The Rabbis and wise men rejected him while the simple people accepted him. The intellectuals had no use for him; but the humble welcomed him. Today therefore, he condemns intellectual pride outrightly whilst exalting lowliness and humility; a humility that accepts God totally.

** Beloved brothers and sisters in the Lord, among the many ** features of infants are their total dependence on their ** parents, their naivety and acceptance of whatever is given ** them, their blind trust and faith in their parents etc. These ** apply well to the ideal Christian who submits his will to that of ** the Father, who follows Christ to wherever he leads, who ** humbly obeys the tenets of his/her faith without questions ** and so on. No doubt Jesus would want his followers to be ** well educated and informed; he'd however not want any of ** his disciple to fall prey to the incurable malady called pride, ** for God opposes the proud but favors the humble (James ** 4:6, Prov. 3:34).*


