Reflection of the Week by Fr. Leo Ahanotu

** Every one of us listens to multiple voices. They come
** from Facebook, radio, television, tweets, Instagram,
** newspapers, family, friends, etc. While some of the voices
** are good and informative, some could be distractive or
** destructive. The prophet, Isaiah, invites us in today's Gospel
** to listen to the eternal life-saving voice of John the Baptist –
** the John who came as a messenger to ask us to "prepare
** the way of the Lord" and "level its paths." John's words are
** words of invitation to prepare for the Lord, who comes into
** the world to teach us to love God and one another, free us
** from sin, and deliver us from evil.

How do we prepare? We prepare by living a life of holiness, love, peace, honesty, justice, integrity, honesty, humility, etc., - an invitation to right living that requires fidelity to the one and God.

John indicated the greatness of the Lord by saying that he, John, is not worthy to untie the Lord's sandals. We should not forget that Our Lord exemplified His greatness with services such as washing feet and looking after others for us to emulate.

Isaiah asks us in the first reading to lower every

mountain and hill and make a highway for the Lord, which
refers to preparation for the Lord to enter our hearts and
homes. He was referring to the mountain of hostility,
domestic violence, taking what does not belong to us, and
unforgiving attitudes. Like John, Isaiah wants us to embrace
spirituality, morality, and love. These will remove the hills
and mountains in our hearts and make a highway for the
hord to cruse directly into our hearts and direct our Christian
life.
