Reflection on the Readings by Fr. Leo

Remain Strong in Faith and Expect God's Salvific Reward!

In today's readings, we encounter the story of faith and * the salvation that goes with it. The first reading reminds us * of the unwavering faith of Abraham to willingly sacrifice * his only son. Isaac. in obedience to God, before God 型 asked him to stop and instructed him to use the ram * beside him for the sacrifice. Abraham was a wealthy man *who had hundreds of cattle and sheep. Yet, he obeyed * the command of God to leave his wealth and move to * another land (Gen 12:4). Abraham's faith in doing the will *of God reminds us of the sacrifices we make in this period * of Lent because of our faith in God as we journey to the The Glory of being with God in heaven forever. Abraham * surrendered his will to God's will. Likewise, we are called * to surrender our will to God's will for the Glory that awaits *us. In all situations, good or bad, let us not give up God's * will and perfect plan for us.

* St. Paul put it better in the second reading by asking subsection up us to have confidence in God's love and protection no matter the challenges or obstacles we face. Nothing should separate us from the love of God.

An exciting connection between the first reading and the gospel is that Jesus, whom God wanted to be sacrificed for the salvation of humanity, is also a descendant of Abraham. Unlike Isaac, Jesus became the natural sacrificial lamb that was slain for the salvation of the world. The story of the transfiguration in the gospel reveals a glimpse of the heavenly Glory that awaits us if we obey God with true faith in good times and bad times. At the mountain, the Father said, "This is my beloved son; listen to him." In the voice, we are called to pay attention to the teachings of Christ in our journey of faith.


