# **Prepare Yourselves to Live a Eucharistic Lent**

Lent is about going spiritually to the state of the desert,
about uniting ourselves to, and imitating, Jesus' fasting,
praying and charity. It's a time to repent and believe.

\* We are summoned to render our hearts open to God, \* to reflect on the meaning and trajectory of our life, as we \* recall that we are dust and to dust we shall return. It's a \* period of mercy and conversion, of grace and holiness \* that we are supposed to receive fruitfully and not in vain.

\* This Lent is special, taking place within the parish
\* phase of the three-year-plus Eucharistic Revival. Since
\* Jesus in the Eucharist is the source and summit, the root
\* and center of the Christian life, Lent, too, should draw its
\* life from the Eucharistic Jesus and lead us to him. It's
\* important, therefore, to look at our major Lenten practices
\* through a Eucharistic lens.

\* So this Lent is a sacred and propitious time to \* recommit ourselves to these essential Eucharistic \* dimensions of our Christian existence, as we, through \* fasting hunger for Christ in the Mass, go into the desert to \* adore him outside of Mass, are impelled by him within \* toward Eucharistic charity, and are commissioned by him \* to proclaim his presence by word and life.


