MISSION AND MEANS



“Mission and Means” is a section in the parish bulletin directed toward the mission of our parish and the means available to accomplish it. It functions to highlight important parish events and especially opportunities to participate in the ongoing mission we all share.

EASTER SEASON

In the liturgical tradition of the Church, Easter is celebrated for fifty days. The entire Easter season unfolds the Resurrection of Jesus through its Scripture readings and prayers. The Scripture is especially helpful as our teacher. In the Easter readings we recognize ourselves in the experiences of the earliest disciples. They feel doubt, shame, fear, disappointment, as well as joy, hope and challenge. At times we think of those early disciples as men and women of perfect faith. But that was not immediately the case. They grew in their understanding, faith and hope. They learned to live Easter life. It helps us to appreciate our discipleship and spiritual lives are also the product of experience and growth. Walking with the Risen Lord, we too should have confidence that God is through us to do remarkable things in our world.

EASTER SACRAMENTS

In addition to the 22 men and women who received the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil, in these weeks of late April and early May over 200 second graders will receive First Holy Communion and over 200 eighth graders (and others) will receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. As a parish, we offer our congratulations to them as they enhance the strength of our sacramental community of Catholic faith.

Letter from Bishop Zubik on the Election of a New Pope

My dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

“And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it.” (Matthew 16:18)

As Jesus spoke these words to Saint Peter, He also spoke them to the 265 successors of Saint Peter. Soon again, Jesus will speak these words to the newly elected Pontiff.

As we turn our hearts and prayers toward Rome, awaiting the election of our next Holy Father, we need to remember the profound truth that guides this sacred process: it is the Holy Spirit who guides our Church.

The cardinal electors, gathered in conclave, are undertaking a truly spiritual reflection and deliberation. They are seeking, through prayer and discernment, to identify the man who will best serve Jesus as the successor to his apostle Peter, the “rock” upon which Christ built His Church.

May we place our trust in the Holy Spirit, who works through the Church and within the hearts of the cardinal electors. May we pray that their discernment will be guided by divine wisdom, leading to the election of a shepherd who will faithfully serve our Lord and lead us in unity and love.

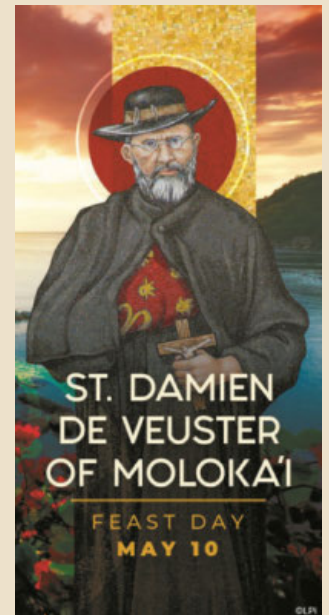

St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka'I May 10

People may be familiar with leprosy from Biblical times, but not so much in the 1800s. However, St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka'I (January 3, 1840 – April 15, 1889) would eventually shed a light on the effects of this devastating disease and allow people to see those afflicted with it with more compassion and love.

Born Joseph de Veuster in Tremelo, Belgium, he quit school at 13 so he could work on the family farm. Feeling called for more, however, he entered the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary six years later, where he took the name of a fourth-century physician and martyr. His brother, a priest from the same congregation, fell ill and was unable to go to his assigned location. Damien quickly volunteered in his place and found himself on the Hawaiian Islands in 1864. Two months after arriving, he was ordained a priest of Honolulu and assigned to the Island of Hawaii.

In 1873, he visited the Hawaiian government's leper colony on the island of Moloka'I, where he petitioned to stay permanently to care for their physical, medical, and spiritual needs. After years of working to improve their location and those who lived there, he contracted Hansen's disease and died of its complications. He found strength to endure isolation and disease in Eucharistic adoration and the celebration of the Mass. St. Damien was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 11, 2009. St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka'I, pray for us!

- Note: Once you join the parish community page, you can only access the parish community page on your smart phone or iPad. You cannot access the parish community page via the web browser on a computer.
- **\$1/month Trial** - If you're brand new to Hallow, you'll be given a special \$1/month for 9 months trial offer which gives access to all the app's premium content. If you wish to continue to gain full-access to the premium content, you will get 20% off the subscription once the 9-month trial ends. *If you'd like to forgo and remain on the free version, simply hit "Skip" and you'll have access to our parish page.*
- **Free Version** - If you're brand new to Hallow, and don't want to participate in the \$1/month for 9 months trial. Then, you can simply join the parish page, and you will have access to the free content on the app plus the prayer challenges.
