

MISSION AND MEANS



"Mission and Means" is a section in the parish bulletin directed toward the mission of our parish and the means available to accomplish it. It functions to highlight important parish events and especially opportunities to participate in the ongoing mission we all share.

THE TIME BETWEEN ASCENSION AND PENTECOST

There was a unique interval between when Jesus ascended to heaven and before the Holy Spirit descended at Pentecost. It was a very challenging time. There must have been a feeling of "aloneness" for the disciples. They must have missed the physical presence of Jesus in their lives and had no idea what the "Advocate" promised by Jesus would be like. Such feelings occur in our own lives as well. But the abiding presence of Jesus and the powerful gifts of the Holy Spirit provide us with the strength we need in the most challenging of times.

OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Within the boundaries of our parish there are three Catholic Schools: Saint Kilian Catholic School, Holy Sepulcher Catholic School and North Catholic High School. We value that presence and thank the administrators and teachers who daily provide an educational environment that has as its goal the formation of Christ-centered young people. ASK FATHER BOBER

QUESTION

I have been told different things; would you please tell me how many times a person is permitted to receive Holy Communion on any one day?



ANSWER

Canon 917 of the current universal law of the Church states that a person who has received Communion once on a particular day may do so again at an Eucharistic celebration in which they participate. Thus, we are limited to receiving communion twice a day and that reception must involve genuine participation in the celebration.

OUESTION

What is the current rule for fasting before receiving Holy Communion?

ANSWER

Canon 919 of the current law of the Church states that a person should abstain from any food or drink (with the exception of water or medicine) for one hour before the reception of the Eucharist. The commentaries on the law indicate that the medication may be liquid or solid and need not be prescribed by a physician. It is also important to note that the hour precedes reception of communion and not the beginning of Mass.

SAINT NORBERT June 6


Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten (c. 1075 -1134), was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany, however, at court it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power, and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God while traveling in a storm he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert and he became penitent, left his court post, and after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes but at the Pope's request finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine order established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded a women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament, this earned him the title "Apostle of the Blessed Sacrament". He and those of his orders had a great love of and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, with a devout faith in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Eventually he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later he traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II, against the antipope. Afterward he returned to Germany to court of Emperor Lothar as advisor, at end of life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg where he died. St. Norbert of Xanten, pray


