

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

HOW LONG WILL THE CAMPAIGN LAST?

Solicitations for our Forward in Faith and Hope campaign will take place through June 2026. Donations and pledges will continue for up to five years. The campaign is designed to allow ample time to formalize our building plans, communicate those plans to the parish, and personally invite each registered household to prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift that is right for them.

WHEN WILL I BE ASKED TO SUPPORT FORWARD IN FAITH?


The campaign will be conducted in phases, allowing us to build momentum, recruit a sufficient number of campaign volunteers, and make our request to each parishioner as personal as possible. This means that some families will be contacted by our Campaign leadership team before the end of 2025, and that process will continue into 2026.

CAN I JUST GIVE NOW?

The short answer is yes, you can! However, it's important to share greater details about our construction plans and campaign goal before asking each of you to prayerfully consider your support. If you feel too excited to wait, please visit our website and click "Contact me about a future donation and/or pledge" or call the parish office.

ARE THERE BENEFITS TO MAKING A GIFT THIS TAX YEAR?

Depending on your situation, making a gift or initial payment before December 31 may be advantageous from a tax perspective. For example, those 70.5 years or older may wish to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) for 2025 – for those 73 or older, this may qualify as part of their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). Others may find themselves exceeding the standard deduction and wish to bundle or bunch charitable giving this year. If you believe this may apply to you, we encourage you to contact your financial or tax professional to seek their guidance regarding tax-efficient giving. You can also contact the parish office to speak with a member of the campaign leadership team.

ST. JOHN XXIII

OCTOBER 11

On October 11th, we celebrate John XXIII, the pope who was first a pastor. Born in Italy at the turn of the 19th century, he was ordained in 1904. His priestly assignments brought him in close contact with the faithful time and time again. He served as a seminary professor, an assistant to the bishop leading pilgrimages and social programs, and a medic and chaplain during World War I. After his ordination as a bishop, he served in Bulgaria, Turkey, and Greece to assist the Church there in her dialogue with Muslims and other Christian communities. John XXIII would bring this concern for personal dialogue into his papacy. He convened the Second Vatican Council to promote renewal in the Church as it faced the

challenges of the modern world. St. John XXIII, pray for us!




