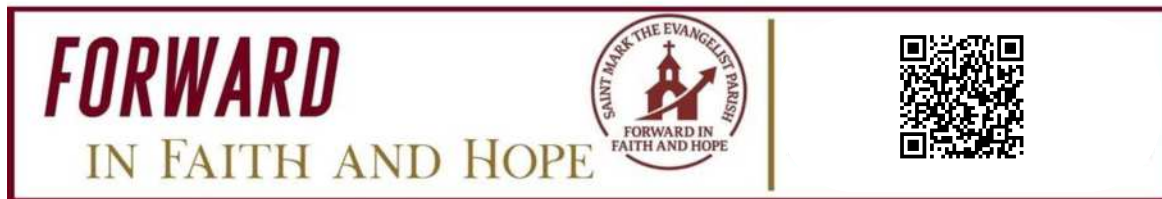

THANKSGIVING MASSES

Thursday, November 27th, our nation once again celebrates Thanksgiving Day. This is a cherished time for family, gratitude, and reflection. It is also a feast that has a deep meaning for us as Catholics.

The word "Eucharist" comes from a Greek word meaning "to give thanks." From the very beginning of our faith tradition, each time we celebrate Mass we are celebrating our personal and communal "thanksgiving." Masses will be celebrated on Thanksgiving Day at 9:00 a.m. in each of our churches. Our local Thanksgiving traditions include bringing up in an offertory procession non-perishable items and monetary gifts. The food will be used by our parish food pantry as well as Glade Run Food Bank. Monetary gifts will be used by our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society to provide essential support to parishioners and neighbors. In addition, small loaves of bread will be blessed and at the end of Mass may be taken home to begin your family Thanksgiving meal. In this way, we hope to unite the Lord's banquet with your family table. Extra loaves may be taken for your neighbors who are unable to get to Mass on Thanksgiving Day.

ST. ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY

Feast Day November 17

Although her life was short, St. Elizabeth of Hungary (1207 – 1231) is recognized for her love of the poor and suffering, and as patroness of Catholic charities and the Secular Franciscan Order. The daughter of the King of Hungary, she chose a life of penance instead of leisure, which made an impact on the “commoners” she served.

St. Elizabeth married Louis of Thuringia when she was 14. Deeply in love, they had three children. Despite their wealth, she led a life of prayer, sacrifice, and service to the poor and sick under the spiritual direction of a Franciscan friar.

After six years of marriage, her husband died in the Crusades, and St. Elizabeth was grief-stricken. Her husband’s family did not look kindly upon her and mistreated her before finally throwing her out of the palace. However, the return of her husband’s allies from the Crusades resulted in her being reinstated, since her son was legal heir to the throne.

St. Elizabeth joined the Secular Franciscan Order in 1228 where she cared for the poor in a hospital she founded in honor of St. Francis of Assisi. She died in 1231, but her great popularity resulted in her being named a saint only four years later.

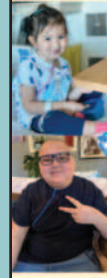
