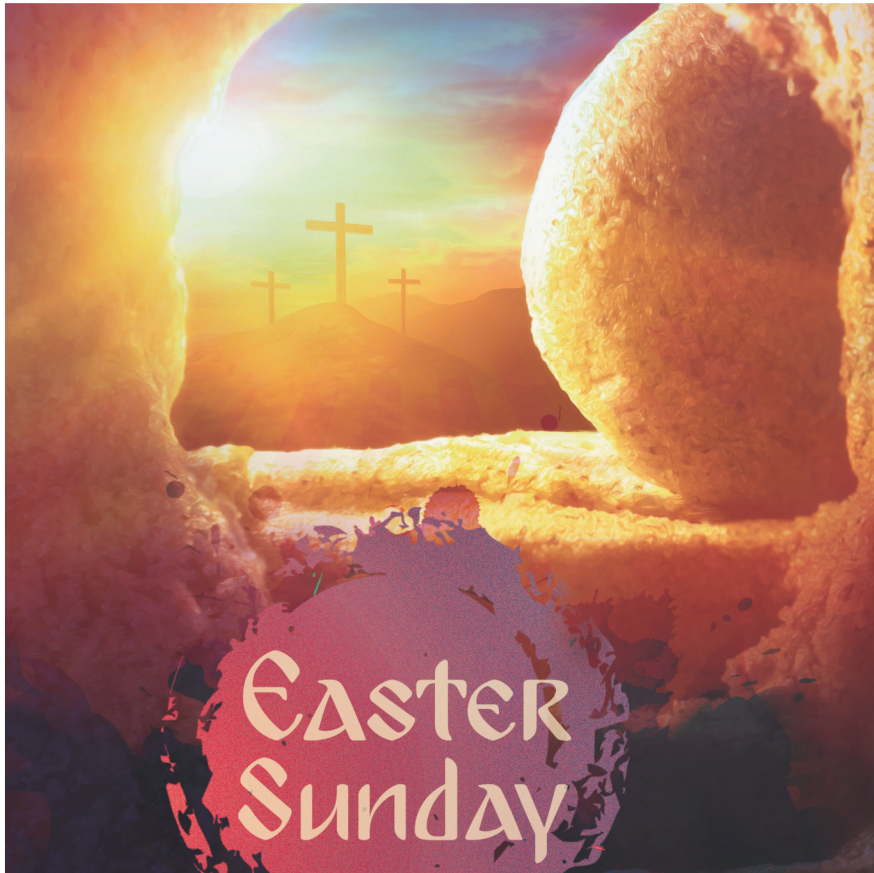

Construction begins this Spring!

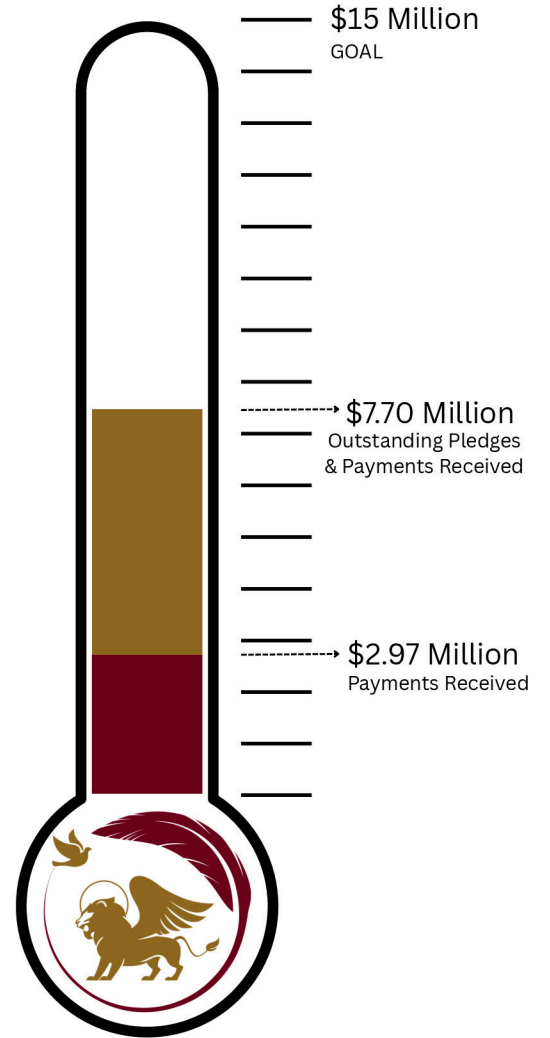

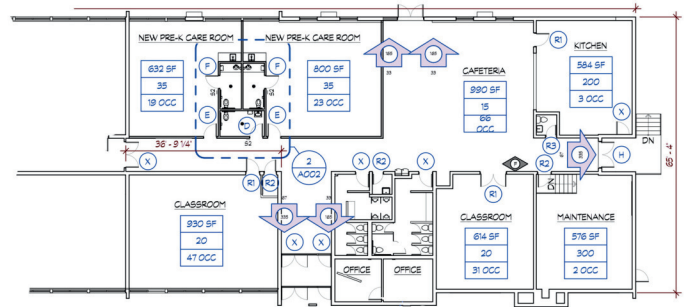
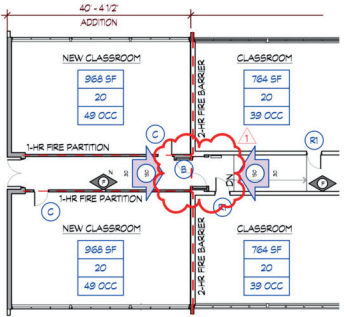

THE DIFFERENCE IS EASTER

At Easter, we celebrate that our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, conquered death, rose from the dead, and remains very much alive. To the world of non-believers: what!? It is quite a big reality to swallow. But for the believer, it is a reality that inspires us to the point where we find ourselves constantly sharing the Gospel with everyone we meet! Right?

So what does Easter mean to you? The question is not what do you believe. The question is, what impact does Easter have on you? How do your actions demonstrate the power of Easter? What does it mean we you hear that we, the Church, are an Easter people?

You may be saying right now that you have no intention of becoming an evangelist, passing out Bibles to all you meet. But I would like to suggest that you actually have a more powerful way of evangelizing others: everyday stewardship. Actions speak louder than words and the way you live your life can be a great testimony to all those you encounter. By acknowledging the gifts you have been given, cultivating those so they grow to an increase, and then sharing them fully with God and with others in God's name will give testimony to your belief that Jesus is alive and seeking a relationship with each of his people.

If more of us won't live our lives in this manner, then non-believers and non-intentional disciples will ask the question, "What difference does Easter make anyway?" Jesus died and rose for you and me. To be sure, it DOES make a difference.

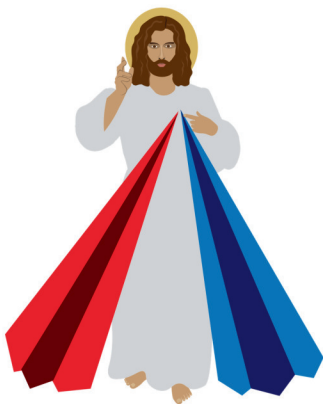
DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

We invite you to join us for the Feast of Divine Mercy, which will be celebrated with a prayer service (not a mass) on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12, 2026 at 2:30pm at Holy Sepulcher Church.

Jesus promises that the soul that's been to Confession and receives Holy Communion will be completely wiped away of the two stains that are on our souls. Those stains are sin and the punishment due to sin. The special grace promised by our Lord for Divine Mercy Sunday is nothing less than the equivalent of a complete renewal of baptismal grace in the soul. To receive the extraordinary graces of this feast, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the vigil celebration), by making a good Confession beforehand and staying in the state of grace, and receiving with great trust in Divine Mercy. It is a way to really start over in our spiritual life!

If you are unable to join us for this prayer service but have met the above conditions, Father Chris Alar, Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception at Divine Mercy Shrine, recommends you offer up this prayer on Divine Mercy Sunday:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, you promised St. Faustina that the soul who has been to confession [I have] and the soul that receives Holy Communion with trust in Divine Mercy [I am] will receive complete forgiveness of all sins and punishment. Lord, please give me this grace. Jesus, I Trust in You.

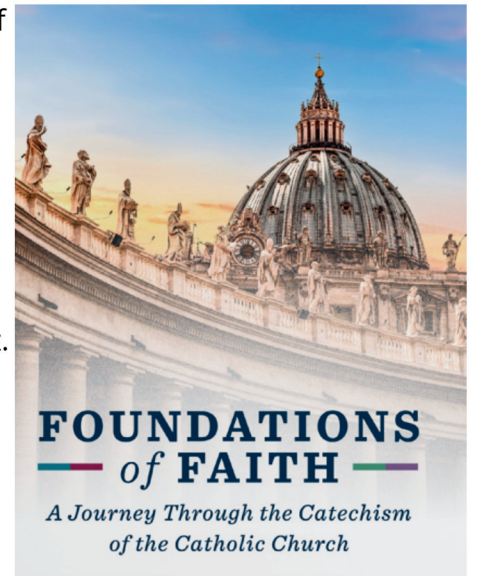

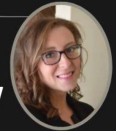
