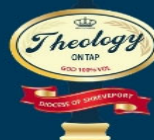

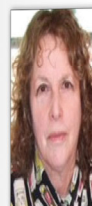

Existen ya tantas y tantas páginas sobre este tema, y las páginas más bellas y fascinantes son las que se han escrito no con tinta, sino con el amor, la sangre y la vida misma. Creo que todos guardamos en nuestra memoria testimonios muy hermosos y admirables de esposos cristianos, que han sido ejemplo de auténtico amor y fidelidad conyugal a lo largo de su vida, a pesar de las mil dificultades de todos los días. Más aún, es precisamente en las pruebas donde este amor se acrisola, y el paso de los años agigantan y embellecen la fidelidad. ¿Es lícito divorciarse? Nuestro Señor nos da la respuesta clarísima en el Evangelio de hoy.

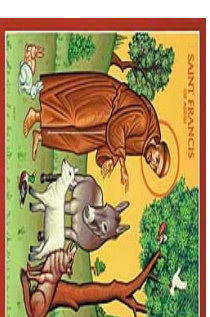

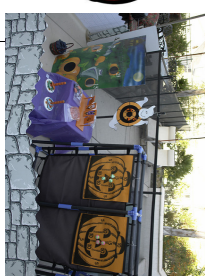

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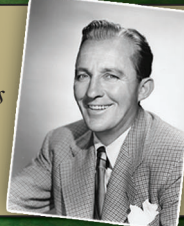


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
