New Horizons The Storm at Sea

MY STORY

We have all been through times in which life seemed like a wave crashing down upon us. And in the midst of those challenges, it seemed as if God were far away

THE STORY OF MARK'S COMMUNITY

The Gospel that we heard proclaimed in today's Mass spoke to what the disciples of Mark's community were experiencing. Mark's community lived in Rome and experienced the persecution of the Roman Emperor Nero. Many of the Christians in Rome lost their lives in that persecution.

THE STORY OF JOB AND THE PSALM

In the Old Testament the sea was thought to be a place of chaos, evil and death. At the beginning of creation, it was believed that God brought order to the waters of the earth. To be buffeted by a storm at sea was to be caught in extreme terror.

The Book of Job deals with the relation of suffering to human behavior. Is suffering always a punishment? Why do the innocent suffer?

From the midst of his suffering Job challenges God about the suffering that he is experiencing. In the reading from Job, God shows that only he created the sea and only he brought limits to the sea. The creation of the sea shows both the power and love of God. The Book of Job shows that the wise person finds meaning in suffering and trusts that the Lord governs the universe with purpose.

Psalm 107 is the Responsorial Psalm of today's Mass. In the psalm sailors experience a storm at sea. Only God is able to calm the storm at sea. Psalm 107:6, 29. "He hushed the storm to a gentle breeze, and the billows of the sea were stilled." The sailors give thanks to God for His saving work on their behalf.

THE STORY OF JESUS

Today's Gospel takes place late at night. There is a terrible storm at sea and waves are breaking over the boat. While the boat is being tossed by the sea Jesus is lying in the stern of the boat asleep on a cushion. The disciples are afraid for their lives and believe that Jesus is not paying attention to their plight.

They lack faith in the powerful Word of Jesus which can conquer the evil powers of the wind and the waves. They wake Jesus up and ask whether he cares that they are perishing. Jesus merely said, "Quiet! Be still (Mark 4:39)!" The wind ceased and there was a great calm. The forces of nature are submissive to him. In calming the sea Jesus does what only God can do. Jesus is the presence and agent of God.

The Gospel points to the lack of faith of the disciples. They still do not understand the identity of Jesus. The reading also shows that faith is a process that takes time, often much time, to develop. The disciples ask, "Who then is this, whom even wind and sea obey (Mark 4:41)?" The reading not only shows the power of Jesus but also challenges us to trust that Christ does protect us from all of the challenges that come against us in life.

FATHERS LEAD TO CHRIST

Today we celebrate Father's Day. We give thanks for our fathers. This reading challenges the fathers of this community to have faith and trust in Christ especially in the most challenging of times.

LA HISTORIA DE LA COMUNIDAD DE MARK

El Evangelio que proclamamos en la Misa de hoy habló de lo que los discípulos de la comunidad de Marcos estaban experimentando. La comunidad de Marcos vivió en Roma y experimentó la persecución del emperador romano Nerón. Muchos de los cristianos en Roma perdieron la vida en esa persecución.

LA HISTORIA DE JOB Y EL SALMO

En el Antiguo Testamento se pensaba que el mar era un lugar de caos, maldad y muerte. Al principio de la creación, se creía que Dios trajo orden a las aguas de la tierra. Ser azotado por una tormenta en el mar era ser atrapado en el terror extremo.

El Libro de Job trata de la relación del sufrimiento con el comportamiento humano. ¿El sufrimiento es siempre un castigo? ¿Por qué sufren los inocentes?

Desde el medio de su sufrimiento, Job desafía a Dios sobre el sufrimiento que está experimentando. En la lectura de Job, Dios muestra que sólo él creó el mar y sólo él trajo límites al mar. La creación del mar muestra tanto el poder como el amor de Dios. El Libro de Job muestra que la persona sabia encuentra significado en el sufrimiento y confía en que el Señor gobierna el universo con propósito.

El Salmo 107 es el Salmo Responsorial de la Misa de hoy. En el salmo los marineros experimentan una tormenta en el mar. Solo Dios es capaz de calmar la tormenta en el mar. Salmo 107:6, 29. "Él ahogó la tormenta a una brisa suave, y los ondulados del mar fueron apaciguados." Los marineros dan gracias a Dios por Su obra salvadora en su nombre.

LA HISTORIA DE JESÚS

El Evangelio de hoy tiene lugar a altas horas de la noche. Hay una terrible tormenta en el mar y las olas están rompiendo sobre el barco. Mientras el barco está siendo arrastrado por el mar, Jesús está acostado en la popa del barco dormido en un cojín. Los discípulos temen por sus vidas y creen que Jesús no está prestando atención a su difícil situación.

Carecen de fe en la poderosa Palabra de Jesús que puede conquistar los poderes malignos del viento y las olas. Despiertan a Jesús y le preguntan si le importa que estén pereciendo. Jesús simplemente dijo: "¡Calla! ¡Estad quietos (Marcos 4:39)!" El viento cesó y hubo una gran calma. Las fuerzas de la naturaleza son sumisas a él. Al calmar el mar, Jesús hace lo que sólo Dios puede hacer. Jesús es la presencia y el agente de Dios.

El Evangelio señala la falta de fe de los discípulos. Todavía no entienden la identidad de Jesús. La lectura también muestra que la fe es un proceso que toma tiempo, a menudo mucho tiempo, para desarrollarse. Los discípulos preguntan: "¿Quién es entonces esto, a quién obedecen incluso el viento y el mar (Marcos 4:41)?" La lectura no solo muestra el poder de Jesús, sino que también nos desafía a confiar en que Cristo nos protege de todos los desafíos que vienen en nuestra contra en la vida.

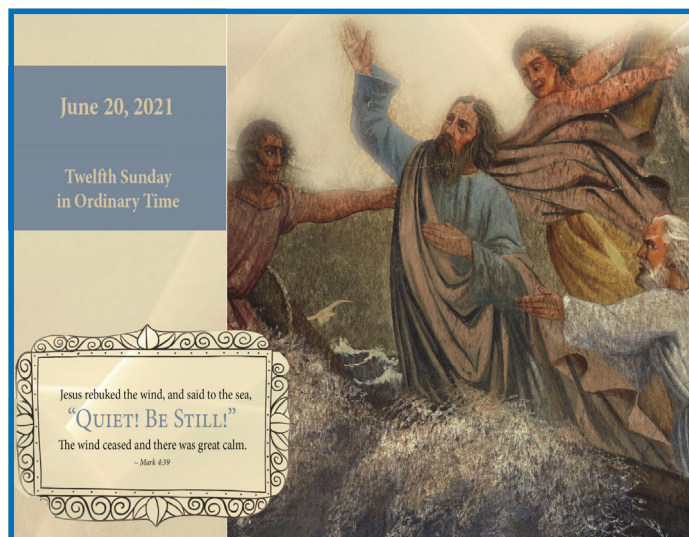

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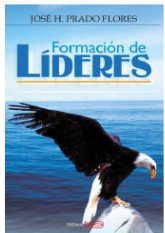
