

2025 Saint John's School of Little Canada Marathon for Non-Public Education

The cost to educate a child at Saint John's School is approximately \$10,000. Tuition covers about half of your child's education. Saint John's parish covers another 25% through their subsidies, and the balance is made up by utilizing parent volunteers and through fundraising.

Our primary annual fundraiser is the **Marathon for Nonpublic Education**. The Marathon is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus Council #4021, and is held at Central Park in Roseville, MN. Students participate in the Marathon by soliciting cash pledges for walking, running, or biking laps around the park. **It is a wonderful community-building event!**

This important fundraiser helps keep our school's tuition in line and raises funds for our school programs. The goal of **\$50,000** is included in this year's school budget; without it, we will need additional financial support or fundraisers.

100% of the proceeds go directly to Saint John's School!

Saturday, October 4th: 9 AM - 12 PM Marathon Day!

Wednesday, October 8th: Last envelope collection day:

Unless we are notified otherwise, matching gifts will be allocated equally between all students from the same family.

MARATHON DAY DETAILS

Saturday, October 4, 2025

The marathon will begin at 9:00 AM at Central Park in Roseville, MN.

Saint John's School will have a tent set up on the East side of Bennett Lake in **Central Park Victoria West** (*please see attached map for address*). Water and snacks will be provided.

Students may choose to either walk or bike around the lake. Marathon Punch Cards, distributed by the Knights of Columbus, will be available at the Marathon Checkpoint on the east side of the lake in **Central Park Victoria West.** Each completed lap around the lake earns one (1) punch on the card.

Parents must accompany their children for the duration of the marathon.

Dogs must be leashed at all times, and their waste must be cleaned up.

The Knights of Columbus will serve complimentary pancakes, sausages, hot dogs, and coffee at the **Foundation Shelter** located in **Central Park Victoria West** (*please see attached map*).

The marathon will end by 12:00 PM.
