

THE LITURGY OF THE DAY

September 10, 2023 The TwentyThird Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ezekiel 33:7-9 / Romans 13:8-10 / Matthew 18:15-20

Matthew writes that Jesus told his disciples that if a sinner will not listen to anyone and will not change the offending behavior, that they should "treat him [or her] as you would a Gentile or a tax collector" (18:17). Initially, this sounds like Jesus is encouraging the disciples to ostracize stubborn sinners. But let's consider how Jesus treated Gentiles and tax collectors. He spent time with them, he responded to their needs, he healed them, he cared for them, he even called them to be his disciples. The disciple who wrote down these words was a tax collector! No matter how the disciples may have interpreted Jesus' words at the time, it became apparent after further reflection that Jesus was not calling them to be dismissive of these sinners, but to reconcile with them.

Question of the Week:

With whom do I need to reconcile? How can I go about it fruitfully?

"You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel..."-Ezekiel 33:7

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confession) Saturday 3:00 - 3:30 p.m. or by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM Adults are baptized at the Easter Vigil as part of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Infant and child Baptisms are by arrangement.

FIRST EUCHARIST Preparation begins in grade one and includes classes, retreats, and home instruction. Children receive First Eucharist in grade two.

CONFIRMATION Our Confirmation program begins in the 9th grade; students are confirmed in the spring of the 10th grade. For young adults who have been baptized but not yet confirmed, contact the parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY It is the policy of the Diocese of Worcester that a couple should contact the parish <u>at least one year</u> prior to the anticipated date of their wedding to allow sufficient time to carry out the various steps of the marriage preparation process. It is important that arrangements be made with the church before plans are made with reception halls, caterers, etc.


