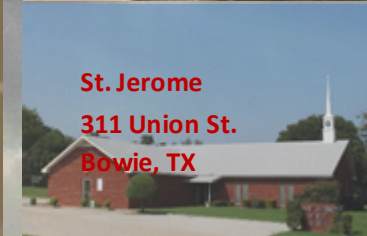

Weekly Reflection

Today's Scripture readings describe leadership as the service of others and portray Jesus as its best example. They explain the *servant leadership* of Jesus, pinpointing service and sacrifice as the criteria of greatness in Christ's kingdom. We need leaders who will help us to form a relationship that will assist us to become what we must be in order to wash one another's feet. We require leaders to call us to the ways of social justice. We need leaders who tie us to other communities and groups who share similar values. Finally, we need leaders who can break open the word for us, who can lead us in our prayer, offering us on the altar, and who can draw us together as sacrament. No one of us possesses all that we as a community need. Our job as *servant leaders* is to evoke, to recognize, to nurture, to celebrate and to help unify the gifts of the Holy Spirit here in our community.

Reflexión Semanal

Ninguno de nosotros posee todo lo que nosotros como comunidad necesitamos. Nuestro trabajo como líderes siervos es evocar, reconocer, nutrir, celebrar y ayudar a unificar los dones del Espíritu Santo aquí en nuestra comunidad.
