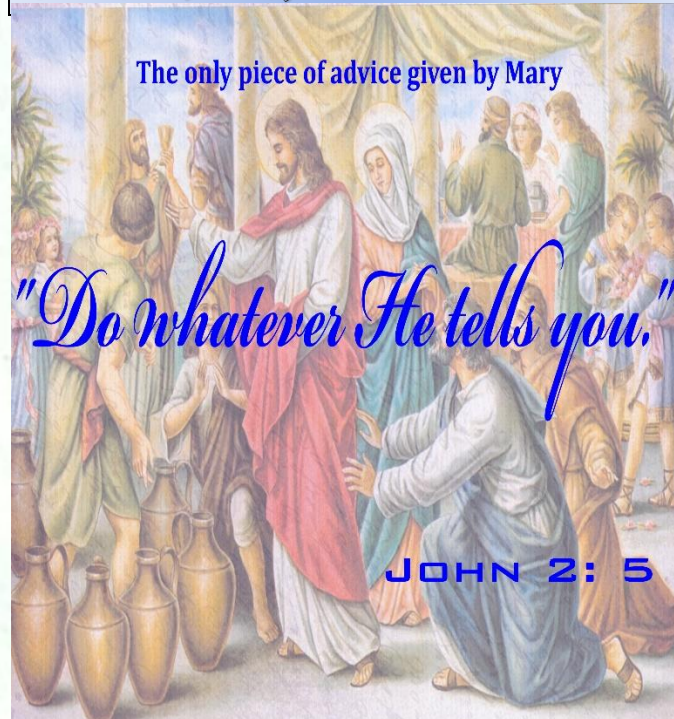

Weekly Reflection

The feast of the Baptism of our Lord presents us with the Third Epiphany or the manifestation of our Lord, the first being the Nativity of our Lord and the second, the feast of the Magi. The Baptism of Jesus was the moment when he passed from the relative obscurity of village life in Nazareth onto the public stage of his mission of proclaiming God's Kingdom. In order to understand today's feast and what took place at the River Jordan, we have to go far beyond seeing Jesus' baptism as a matter of dealing with sinfulness. Baptism is not, as is true of all the sacraments, an isolated ritual. It takes place in the context of our whole life and the life of the community. Whether we are baptized as children or as adults, what primarily is happening is that we become incorporated embodied, into the Christian community. As today's readings tell us, the Sacrament of Baptism is insufficient to save us. We must live our faith in Christ by obeying the commandments of God. This is achieved by shining in our love towards others as a light in the world.

Reflexión Semanal

La fiesta del Bautismo de nuestro Señor nos presenta la Tercera Epifanía o la manifestación de nuestro Señor, siendo la primera la Natividad de nuestro Señor y la segunda, la fiesta de los Reyes Magos. El Bautismo de Jesús fue el momento en que pasó de la relativa oscuridad de la vida de pueblo en Nazaret al escenario público de su misión de proclamar el Reino de Dios. Para entender la fiesta de hoy y lo que tuvo lugar en el río Jordán, tenemos que ir mucho más allá de ver el bautismo de Jesús como una cuestión de lidiar con la pecaminosidad. El bautismo no es, como ocurre con todos los sacramentos, un ritual aislado. Tiene lugar en el contexto de toda nuestra vida y de la vida de la comunidad. Ya sea que seamos bautizados como niños o como adultos, lo que principalmente está sucediendo es que nos incorporamos encarnados, en la comunidad cristiana. Como nos dicen las lecturas de hoy, el Sacramento del Bautismo es insuficiente para salvarnos. Debemos vivir nuestra fe en Cristo obedeciendo los mandamientos de Dios. Esto se logra brillando en nuestro amor hacia los demás como una luz en el mundo.

Pastoral Letter Regarding COVID-19 Omicron, Flu Season, and Continued Safety Protocols

January 13, 2022

"I write to you amidst what public health professionals have identified as the peak of the rapid spread of the COVID-19 Omicron ("O") variant along with the height of the flu season in North Texas. While the effects of the "O" variant seem to be less virulent than the previous strains of COVID—especially for the unvaccinated—nonetheless this variant is spreading rapidly through our community with greater contagion. I am writing to you to encourage you to be prudent and mindful of our protocols with renewed vigilance for safe participation in the celebration of Mass and the other sacraments especially during these next several weeks."
