

Academic Excellence



Our students develop a **Mind** and intellect that allows them to think critically and to make good, morally founded decisions. The outstanding education our students receive also provides them with opportunities for further education. Ninety-nine percent of Catholic School students graduate and eightyeight percent go on to a four year institution. Catholic School students also score up to twenty percent higher on nationally normed assessments and receive more in scholarships.

Gospel Values

Our school gives students a foundation in **Moral Character** and integrity. Catholic School students are fifty percent more likely to report feeling safe at school. They are also less likely to report participating in risky behaviours such as drug and alcohol use and absenteeism. There is a higher likelihood that students will make better, safer decisions in an environment where Catholic values are taught.
